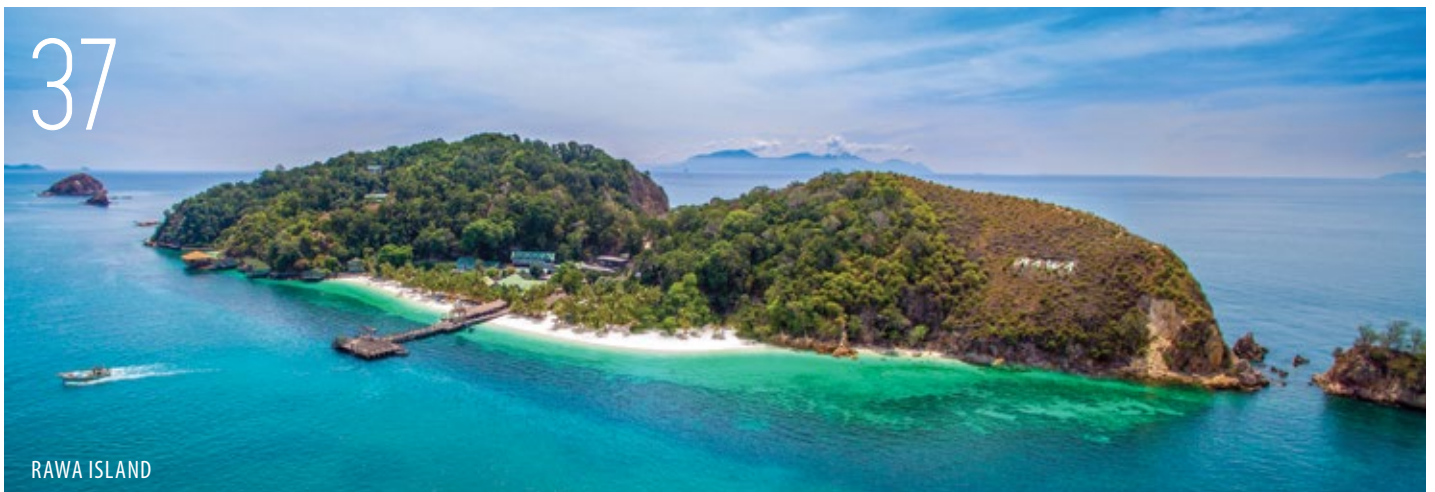

As the night sky turned darker, a total of 20 yachts bedecked in extravagant Christmas lights formed a flotilla and set sail from ONE°15 Marina Sentosa Cove to Harbourfront Cruise Bay. This year's parade was a memorable one. For one, the flotilla entered the Singapore Book of Records for the Largest Parade of Decorated Boats. Amongst the participants were also a group of special guests. 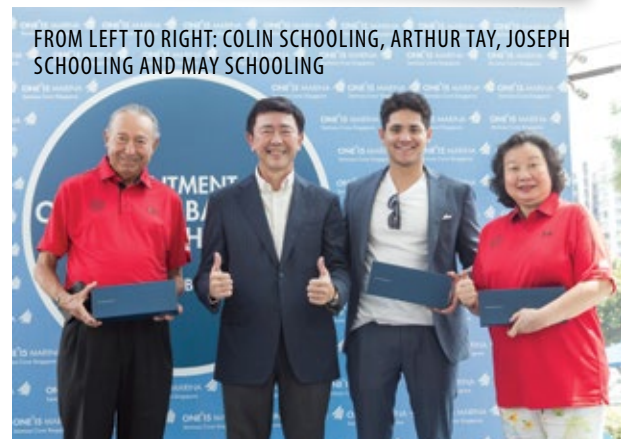

Joseph Schooling made history when he became the first Singaporean to win a gold medal at the world's pinnacle sporting event, the Olympics. Aside from beating his childhood heroes, Joseph also smashed the Olympic record with his timing of 50.39 seconds in the 100m butterfly event. His determination and excellent sportsmanship is inspiring and on 24 November 2016, our national hero was formally instated as ONE°15 Ambassador.

In the midst of a packed schedule of public appearances, Joseph arrived at the Club accompanied by his parents, Colin and May Schooling. He was received warmly by Arthur Tay, Chairman of SUTL Group. 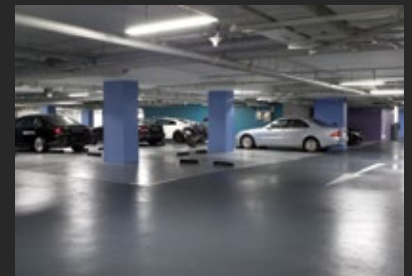

The region is newly independent, and the main art movements within most of these countries started more or less in the 1940s," shares Jasdeep Sandhu, Director of Gajah Gallery. "With the increasing wealth of the region we also find amazing contemporary art being produced as the various societies go through different periods of conflict."

Measuring around 125m in length, the bridge ranks amongst the world's longest curve suspension bridge and receives many visitors through the year. It swings out over the surrounding landscape to give visitors a unique spatial experience, bringing you over and around the mountain

forest for a breathtaking view. Hanging high up in the sky, a walk on the bridge is also a hair-raising and exhilarating adventure.

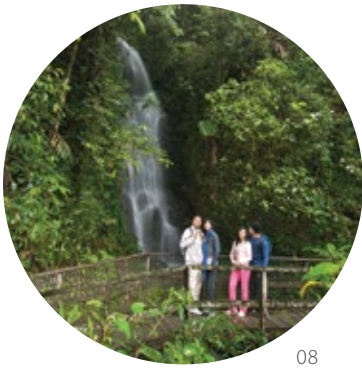

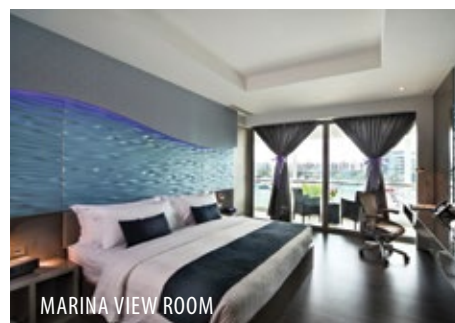
