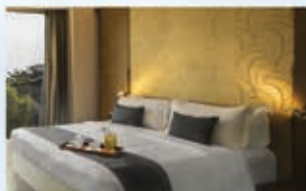

# SUPERYACHTS AT THE SHOW

As the Singapore Yacht Show (SYS) sails its way in this April, we give you a sneak peek of some of the Show's spotlight stealers. Keep a look out for these yachts worthy of a second glance.

## BENETEAU OCEANIS YACHT 62

Making its Asian premiere is the *Beneteau Oceanis Yacht 62*, brought in by one of SYS' first exhibitors, Simpson Marine. Designed by French shipyard Beneteau, the *Oceanis Yacht 62* is elegant on water. The luxury cruiser has a slender profile, characterised by a signature dark hull stripe that conceals a dozen hull ports. An enormous cockpit creates an inviting space for lounging under the sun. Within the cabin, an open and airy layout allows natural light to spill through. Luxurious and majestic, the *Oceanis Yacht 62* is in a class of its own.

## FERRETTI 700

Ferretti returns to the SYS with the 700 in tow, the brand's sportiest looking motoryacht yet. The new *Ferretti 700* is the evolution of one of the greatest recent successes for Ferretti Group's historical brand. It immediately strikes the eye with a sleek and aggressive profile, accentuated by long windows that run from the windscreen to the cockpit. The interior is just as breathtaking. Large windows in the saloon allow passengers to have a complete view of the sea. A combination of space, comfort and contemporary design, the *Ferretti 700* is one of the most covetable yachts in the market.



## AZIMUT 95RPH

The *Azimut 95RPH* is set to make its first appearance in the region. The 94ft vessel is large in size with a big-boat feel, but its innovative design creates the illusion of a slimmer profile. The flybridge is incredibly spacious, accommodating a large dinette for pleasant open-air lunches, a mini-bar, Jacuzzi and a comfortable sunpad area. With double floor-to-ceiling picture windows, the large saloon is bathed with natural light and gives the thrill of looking out over the blue horizon. The *Azimut 95RPH* is quite possibly the boat of your dreams. 📞

# Wild and Windy

TRICKY WEATHER CONDITIONS SET THE STAGE FOR THE SB20 ASIAN GRAND SLAM & ASIA PACIFIC CHAMPIONSHIPS 2017. UNFAZED, PARTICIPANTS WELCOMED THE CHALLENGE AND BATTLED THEIR WAY TOWARDS THE TROPHY.





**H**eld once again at ONE°15 Marina Sentosa Cove, Singapore, the 2017 edition of the race took place from 20 – 22 January. Riding on the success of last year's regatta, the event set a new participant record of 23 teams, comprising 77 participants from various parts of the world.

### DAY ONE

Day One began with much anticipation for some exciting sailing action ahead. The first race of the day started with light wind, giving participants a taste of the weather conditions they would be competing under. The light wind came with shifts to the left and managing this proved to be a challenging task for the sailors. The same conditions characterised the second race but by race three, the breeze had settled more and built to a pleasant eight to 10 knots. Day One concluded with *Walababy*, comprising crew Steven Manning, Alex Gough, Ryan Betonio and Nagisa Sakai winning race one. *Shameless*, helmed by Scott Duncanson and crewed by Peter Gregg and Paul Burke emerged winners of race two while *Team 3LB*, made up of Anthony Kiong, Stanley Chan and Colin Ng scored the win for race three.

As the sailors retreated back to ONE°15, scores for Day One were tallied. Interestingly, none of the three boats that had won a race featured in the top five overall results for the day. Last year's champion *Glasgow Kiss* flew under the radar for much of the races but emerged top of the overall leaderboard. *Team Xcellent* was hot on their heels with second place while *Tara's* strong showing in race three propelled them to third place. Against the weather conditions, it appeared that

consistency throughout the races would be the key to winning the championship.

### DAY TWO

With revised strategies, participants returned for another action-packed Day Two of racing. "We have a tough and very competitive fleet," said Nils Razmilovic, SB20 Singapore Class Captain and crew member of *Glasgow Kiss*, as he sized up the competition. "We managed to win last year by a quarter point and we would be very happy if we could pull that off again. But the main thing is, it's wonderful to see all our friends here, who are all wonderful racers. So no matter what, it would be a good weekend."

Tight starts, close battles and crowded marks got adrenelines pumping during the first two races of the day. However, a huge tropical storm rolled over in the afternoon, reducing visibility to just a few metres. The weather proved to be too dangerous and safety officers elected to end racing for the day. The early finish gave the crews plenty of time ashore to enjoy refreshing beverages at ONE°15.

**O**n the morning of 13 August 2016, Singaporeans kept their eyes peeled onto the television screen. Miles away, racing alongside swimming greats Michael Phelps, Chad le Clos and Laszlo Cseh at the Rio Olympics was the nation's very own Joseph Schooling.

When the then 21-year-old touched the wall first, the entire country cheered. We waited 50.39 seconds for our first Olympic champion to emerge. But for Joseph himself, that moment of glory was something he had been training and waiting for his entire life.

Joseph's love affair with the sport started off when his parents, May and Colin Schooling, took their son for swimming lessons. They had a practical motive – those lessons were meant to help him become water safe. Little did they know, Joseph would soon fall in love with being in the water, so much so that what was supposed to be a life skill turned into a dream career.

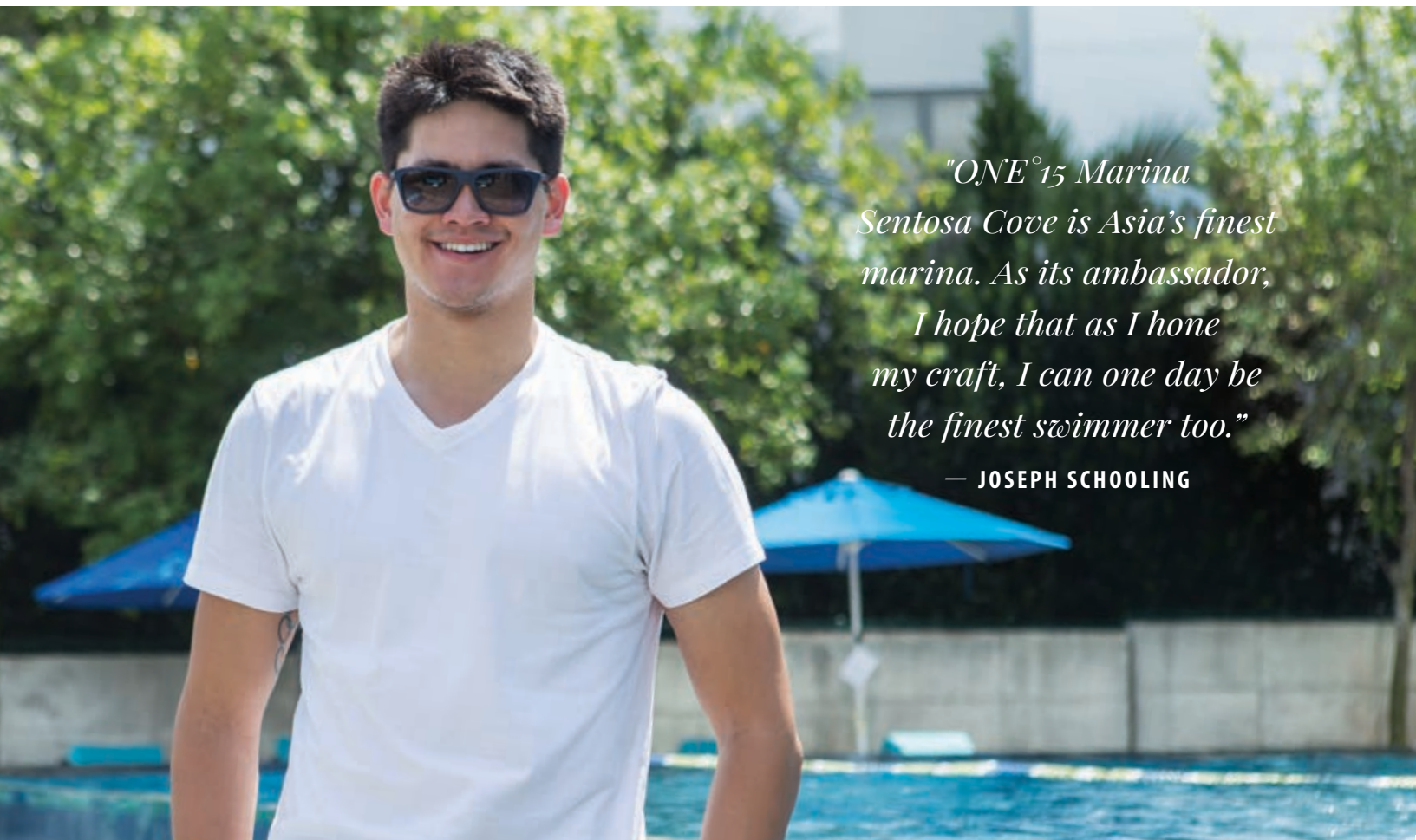
The dream only intensified when Joseph received his first swimming medal at five years old. "After that first win, I was thirsty for more. I knew that I had a real chance to one day do my nation proud," he reveals.

From then on, beneath the youthful exterior of a little boy was a steely conviction to succeed. However, the journey was not smooth sailing. To ensure he had the best shot at making it big one day, Joseph had to take the road less travelled. At just 13, he moved to the US to train at the Bolles School in Florida. Understandably, he struggled to cope with the big change.

"When I was growing up in Singapore, I had my parents and my nanny Auntie Yoli taking care of me. But when I moved to the US, I had to take care of myself," he reminisces. "I was very homesick and missed my family. On top of that, I had to put in hours of training to get to where I am now. I guess when you gain something, you lose something."

Joseph eventually adjusted to life in the US. Today, his road to becoming an excellent swimmer consists of six days of training per week, with up to two sessions in a day. With no time to waste, he wakes up at five am to get ready for morning practice. As a student of the University of Texas, Joseph also has to set aside some time for his studies.

The sacrifices are all worth it. "Being an Olympic Champion is a recognition of the amount of hard work I have put in.

I have enjoyed every single moment of the journey that has taken me to where I am today, including the people that have contributed to my success," he says. "I have no regrets and those are the moments that I cherish when I look at the Olympic medal."

Despite his marvellous Olympic feat, Joseph is far from done. Come July, his eyes are set on breaking the World Record for the 100m butterfly at the 2017 FINA World Championships in Budapest. He is also determined to maintain his number one spot in the Olympic event for as long as he can. That might not come easy. "Maintaining the number one spot is actually harder than achieving it," he divulges.

Although ambitious goals are on the horizon, Joseph is not one to crack under pressure. "I love challenges," he admits. "When you set high expectations for yourself, of course there is pressure. But I am able to handle it because I use it to motivate and push myself."

Beneath the grit and tenacity, Singapore's Golden Boy appears to be like any regular youth. He is an avid soccer and football fan who cheers on his favourite teams – Chelsea FC and New England Patriots – when they play on TV. When his schedule

allows for a bit of free time, he plays computer games with his friends. And despite the many years he has spent abroad, Joseph is still as Singaporean as can be. His most Singaporean trait? "I am very *tam jiak*," he shares candidly. "I love food!"

Although the Olympic win has cast him under the public eye at a young age, Joseph remains unfazed at the attention. He demonstrates maturity beyond his years as he shares his plans for putting his freshly minted status as Olympic Champion to good use. As a public figure, Joseph recognises that his actions can influence the people around him. Thus, he has recently gotten involved in giving back to society. For one, proceeds from his photo book "Hello, My Name is Joseph Schooling" will go to the Make-A-Wish Foundation. "I think it is important to think of the less fortunate when you have the power of influence," he believes.

Through his journey, Joseph also hopes to inspire swimmers of the next generation to have the courage to pursue their goals. He shares a word of advice for them: "Dream big and train hard. You are stronger than you think and you will never know what you can achieve."

Indeed, even for Joseph Schooling himself, the best is yet to be. ①
