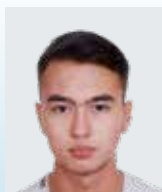

Warm waters, dazzling sunshine and steady breezes. These are the hallmarks of the SB20 Asian Grand Slam & Asia Pacific Championships, and the Club was once again proud to play host to a record number of 23 competing teams from over 10 countries around the world. Happening from 2 – 4 February, this year's regatta promised heated action to come with its star-studded roster of participants. Of particular note were 2016 and 2017 champions, *Glasgow Kiss* and *Tara*, heralding exciting duels for the much-coveted trophy.

### DAY ONE

Slightly overturning expectations, the first day of the races rolled around with strong gusts, sending sheets of rain down on the competitors as they jostled for space at the starting line. Fortunately, the wind settled down to a moderate speed at the appointed hour, and the races were able to begin without a hitch. After a few changes in positions amidst tricky breezes, *Glasgow Kiss* emerged first for the first race, followed by *Wala Baby* and *Tara*.

The trend in shifting wind directions continued in the second and third races, coupled with rocky starts brought about by the high tides generated by the super blue blood moon of the night before. By the end of the day, the sailors returned to the Club to tally the current standings. After its dominating performance

winning all three races of the day, *Glasgow Kiss* led the pack with three points. Close behind was *Wala Baby* with seven points and *Tara* with 11 points. The rest of the fleet was not far behind, making each coming race a chance to fight for the top prize.

### DAY TWO

After a night's rest, the competitors returned bright and refreshed to the starting line for the second day of the regatta. True to the weather forecast, the northeast monsoon conditions whipped itself up into a day of gusty winds and bright sunshine. The swirling 20 to 30 degree shifts in wind direction were a challenge for each team's tactician, seeing who could make the best judgement calls and keep his team in the running for the trophy.

Into the second race, the strong breezes proved overwhelming for Singapore Polytechnic's *Bandit*, as their rig broke and slid into the murky waters, leaving the team stranded. While this served as a reminder to the rest to be cautious in the prevailing conditions, team *Tara* caused great excitement when it shot ahead of the rest at the beginning of the third race. This prompted a visit from the jury boat to check for any unlawful speed gaining actions – but as it turns out, there was no foul play. Instead, Adrian Peach is now handling the tiller, resulting in an immediately obvious difference.

While it looked like it would be a smooth sailing win for *Tara*, *Pocapena* gave *Tara* a run for its money, with both teams going at it hammer and tongs. Ultimately, *Tara* took the win, leading by just half a length, with *Pocapena* settling for second. This also served to snap *Glasgow Kiss*'s unbroken winning streak so far, injecting fresh optimism into the racers as they headed back to land. Unfortunately, the high winds proved to be calamitous to *Sea U Later*, *Wala Baby* and *Scum Bag*, causing a dropped rig, a broken rudder and a broken bow pole for each respectively.

### DAY THREE

After a night and morning of repairs, the sailors were back at the starting line again, faced with the prospect of a light drizzle and good breezes for the last day of the regatta. Two boats were out of the remaining three races due to irreparable damages from the day before – *Bandit* and *Sea U Later*, both with broken rigs. For the rest, it was their final chance to shake up the standings, with *Glasgow Kiss* standing proud at the top with five points, trailed by *Pocapena* with 12 points and *Wala Baby* with 13 points. *Tara* was not far behind in fourth, at 15 points.

By the end of the first race, *Glasgow Kiss* has tightened its grip on the championship trophy with yet another win, but the competition heats up for the remaining podium finishes. *Pocapena* and *Wala Baby* did not disappoint as they fought tooth and nail, and their rivalry propelled both teams to push past *Glasgow Kiss* in the second race to finish first and second. The final race began with *Glasgow Kiss* winning the championship based on its consistent performance through all three days, but the

verdict was still out for the remaining two places. In an uncharacteristic error, the crew on *Glasgow Kiss* failed to pull the spinnaker through in a gybe, resulting in a broach and leaving the field open for *Wala Baby* to take the win for the final race.

At the culmination of the last race, both competitors and spectators alike scrambled to do some rapid mental calculations, and it quickly became apparent that *Pocapena* and *Wala Baby* had fought to the end and tied for second with 19 points each. After tiebreak rules were applied, *Wala Baby* had prevailed over tenacious *Pocapena* to emerge second. Fourth went to *Tara* at 28 points, and *SMU Alumni* filled out the top five.

The excitement was not all over yet, as the tired yet happy fleet made its way back to ONE°15 Marina, where a lavish awards ceremony awaited them on the Rooftop Terrace. Winner *Glasgow Kiss* was presented with the championship trophy to add to their existing trophy from 2016, with all who were present toasting to the win and making plans to return next year for yet another exciting edition of the SB20 Asian Grand Slam & Asia Pacific Championships, scheduled to be held from 24 – 27 January 2019. 📍

# HIDDEN HERO

Behind every delicious meal at the Club are skilled chefs, thoughtful service staff... and hardworking stewards behind the scenes. While they are rarely seen in public, *Longitude* manages to track down Stewarding Supervisor Emel John Paragan – who is also ONE°15's Employee of the Year 2017.

**L** Longitude      **J** Stewarding Supervisor Emel John Paragan

**L** : Hi John! Many of our Members may not be familiar with what you do, so could you tell us a little about your job?

**J** : As stewards, we prepare the equipment and do the set-up for the events under the Food & Beverage (F&B) department. For example, preparing LATITUDE Bistro for lunch, or getting the Constellation Ballroom ready for banquets. Afterwards, we are also in charge of the washing-up.

**L** : Sounds like a lot of work! Can you share a little more in detail about the preparation before each event?

**J** : Sure. Every week there will be lots of F&B events at the Club, so we meet with the chefs and service staff beforehand to discuss about the items they are going to need. The plates and cutlery for each cuisine are different, and the chefs sometimes have live stations, so they require additional equipment like heating lamps and toasters. After the meetings, we start preparing accordingly.

**L** : Given that there is a lot of coordination involved, what is something that you find challenging?

**J** : Last minute changes to the menu and programme. On the day itself, we suddenly find that what we have prepared is not what is needed.

**L** : In these instances, what do you do?

**J** : Communication is key. Since such situations can be quite urgent, we react quickly to solve the problem. If the needed equipment is something we have, we make the switch. If not, we brainstorm with the chefs and service staff to find an alternative. Having worked with my colleagues for a few years, we understand each other and teamwork is second nature.

**L** : Looks like you have a close-knit team here. How long have you been at ONE°15?

**J** : I joined ONE°15 in 2013, so I have been here for about five years.

**L** : You have been working here for quite some time then. Over the years at ONE°15, what is a memory that never fails to make you smile?

**J** : The moment when I was named Employee of the Year. It was surprising because we were all expecting a member of the frontline staff. But this award is not just for me. It is also for the entire stewarding department. It shows that the management acknowledges and appreciates the efforts of back of the house staff.

**L** : What do you think is an important trait for a good steward?

**J** : The patience to communicate well. In this line, we often have to work with others from different backgrounds, and miscommunication can happen. Keeping our cool to get the message across is essential. Also, in my role as a stewarding supervisor, I have to train new staff and explain to them when they get things wrong or forget their instructions. When they are particularly new and confused, this might be several times a day.

**L** : What are your future plans at ONE°15?

**J** : I love my job, and I am happy working here. So I have no intention to go anywhere else. My goal right now is to keep improving and bring greater satisfaction to our Members. 🕒

# VENTURING INTO UNCHARTED WATERS

A relentless boating advocate, Clement Chua, Executive Director of The Boat Shop Asia (TBSA) has combined passion with business. *Longitude* catches up with him to find out how it all began.



CLEMENT CHUA AND FAMILY

When Clement first got his Powered Pleasure Craft Driving License (PPCDL) in 2013, no one wanted to rent him a boat. “I would call these companies one by one, only to have them say, sorry sir, we don’t do bareboat charters,” he shares. “I have never been rejected so many times in my life before.”

While this would have led many others to put their hard-earned licenses away and give up any dreams of driving their own boat, it only spurred Clement on. “I was so frustrated that I went to the U.S., bought my own boat, and had it shipped all the way to Singapore,” Clement reveals. But that was not the end of it. “After talking it over with my wife, Amanda, we realised that a lot of people faced the same issue. So we decided to buy a couple of boats, and start a chartering business.”

And that was how TBSA was born. Four and a half years on, TBSA offers not just bareboat charters, but also a wide range of boating services, including training courses, maintenance and a multitude of sea sports events. In fact, it is now a ‘one-stop shop for everything fun at sea’, as Clement puts it.

Considering Clement’s love for all things boating, it might seem a safe bet to assume that he joined ONE°15 because of the award-winning marina. But that is not so. As it was, Clement was drawn here by another one of his passions: food. In 2010, lured by the promise of good *dim sum*, he tagged along with a colleague to the Club’s Chinese restaurant. “It was a done deal from the moment I tasted the food. The *dim sum* was fantastic, and the view, incredible,” Clement says with enthusiasm. Soon after, he became a Member of the Club.

However, Clement did not stay away from the marina for long. “I was not even a boater then, but the prospect of becoming one at the Club appealed to me. Fast forward to 2013, a childhood friend of mine took me out on a powerboat the day after he got his PPCDL. Being adventurous, I actually agreed. And I never regretted it. The control, the speed, the wind and waves in my face, that thrilled me to the core. From then on, I was hooked,” Clement says.

It is therefore unsurprising that Clement’s favourite facility at the Club is the marina. Despite having berthed at many other marinas over the years, ONE°15 remains the one he always returns to. “It is one of the best equipped and most well-run marinas in the region. If you want an elegant and refined place, this is the best in Singapore,” he explains.

The ONE°15 experience so impressed Clement that in 2017, he decided to set up an office for TBSA on the Club’s premises. As a result, Clement now occupies the unique position of being a Member and running a business that is partly based at the Club. And he is not disappointed. “As a Member, the service staff really make things special. They go the extra mile to understand our tastes and preferences. But it was only after basing TBSA at the Club that I realised that the people at ONE°15 are all professionals. Here, the level of professionalism is consistent, all the way from the management to the service staff. And you don’t get that everywhere,” Clement shares.

Looking forward, what does Clement hope to accomplish with TBSA at ONE°15? “I hope to bring more Members on board with us for an active boating lifestyle,” he says. “If there are any Members who are still held back by unknowns, I hope they can take the plunge and try out an activity they are interested in, be it sea trails or fishing trips. One thing’s for sure – we are all going to have so much fun,” Clement declares with a confident twinkle in his eye. 🚤
