Eleven Fabulous Years

Greetings to all Members and welcome to the anniversary issue of *Longitude*. Recapping the past one year, it has been a fruitful and eventful one. In February, ONE°15 Marina hosted Vega, a 125-year-old wooden boat that transited in our Marina, while bringing supplies to remote areas around the world. The Club is committed to offering our support to vessels on humanitarian missions.

From 12 to 15 April, we hosted the largest number of world-class yachts in Asia at the Singapore Yacht Show, with a total of 94 yachts and watercrafts on display and a record number of 150 exhibitors. This annual event has been growing from strength to strength and we are confident that future editions will be bigger and better.

Besides hosting one of the most prestigious yacht shows in the world, the Club once again clinched the Best Asian Marina award (the 7th time) at the Asia Boating Awards—a noteworthy recognition of our high standard of technical and service excellence.

At the staff level, several team members also won awards including the Outstanding Performance Award (Individual), CEO Star Award, Outstanding Collaboration Award, EXSA 2018 silver category and SHA – Employee of the Year Award.

Apart from providing a stellar Club and marina for our Members, we are also passionate about protecting the sea and ensuring that our rich marine biodiversity continues to flourish. Since 2017, we've stepped up our conservation efforts, which include a bi-annual Eco-Dive initiative that brought over 100 people together to clean up the marina. Our volunteers removed more than 200kg of trash from our waters in the latest edition held in March.

To celebrate ONE°15 Marina's 11th anniversary this year, the Club is launching the Coral Garden Project and Eco-Exhibition as our pledge to protect, maintain and develop the ecosystem in our Marina (see page 10).

Our long-term vision is to develop the Coral Garden as an education site for children to explore marine biodiversity in a safe and controlled environment. We are also planting coral reefs in order to help protect marine organisms and create a healthy environment for them to grow.

The Eco-Exhibition, on the other hand, aims to raise awareness on the importance of sustainability as the key to a thriving marine ecosystem, covering topics from water pollution to responsible fishing. Please join us at this meaningful exhibition and coral planting event on 6 October, from 9am to 3pm.



In recent months, we have enhanced our offerings and hardware to improve your experience at the Club, including renovation of the Hillview Rooms, screening World Cup at Boaters' Bar, a new weekend dim sum buffet menu, and the addition of premium brands like illy, Gryphon Tea Company and Häagen Dazs to our refreshment offerings.

Some upgrading plans in the pipeline include a revamp of the Suite rooms, replacement of pontoon gates and fuel dock pontoons as well as the addition of CCTVs in the Club for enhanced security.

As part of our continuous effort to extend the benefits of our Members, we have added the historic and elegant Swiss Club to our list of affiliate clubs and have continued our monthly member-exclusive events and with greater variety. Some examples include the Mercedes AMG Nikkei Sake Experience, Children's Cooking Class, fitness workshops, networking cocktails with other affiliate clubs, which are communicated to Members via e-newsletters and the website. Members with kids will also be delighted with our new activity line-up, which includes bi-monthly movie screenings (page 16) and pool parties as well as themed events such as the Taco Party. We will continue to introduce interesting events while expanding popular ones such as the upcoming Halloween event, which is organised at a Sentosa Cove level (page 23).

This November, we look forward to organising the highly anticipated ONE15 Christmas Boat Light Parade. Highlights of previous editions include the holiday market, snow globe and Christmas Tree Light Up ceremony. We believe this year's edition will be just as fun, if not more, especially with the continued support from SCRM and CDL this year. We look forward to celebrating the Yuletide season with you at the Club.

On a final note, I'll like to extend my appreciation to all our Members for your unwavering support the last 11 years. Here's to many more!

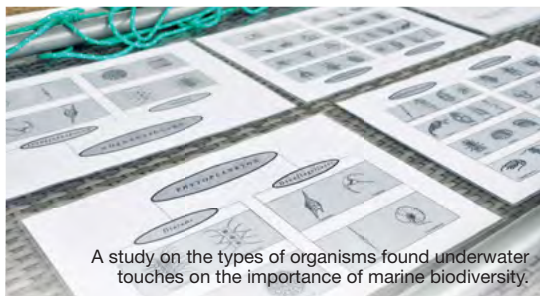
Known as rainforests of the sea, coral reefs are rare and mighty. Even though they occupy less than one per cent of the ocean floor, it is estimated that a quarter of all marine life is supported by corals for at least one stage of its life cycle, according to a BBC report.

The Club is launching the Coral Garden Project, an eco-initiative in partnership with SeaKeepers Asia, the Asia arm of The International SeaKeepers Society, as a meaningful way to mark our 11th anniversary while protecting the environment.

On 6 October, we will plant corals in the marina with the help of NUS Reef Eco Labs, to provide additional habitat and shelter for diverse sea life to grow and thrive, in the hope of ultimately creating a flourishing marine eco-system.

It is our long term vision that children will be able to dive in the Coral Garden, a safe and controlled area, as well as explore the marine environment while learning about the importance of protecting its biodiversity.

Based in the US, The International SeaKeepers Society was founded by a group of yacht owners in 1998. The non-profit organisation supports marine science and conservation efforts via their Discovery Yachts Programme through direct involvement with the yachting community to participate in scientist-led expeditions, instrument deployments, community activities and educational outreach programmes. As part of their educational outreach sessions to target youth, private yachts act as Floating Classrooms with a focus on educating them on marine wildlife and sustainability issues such as plastic pollution.

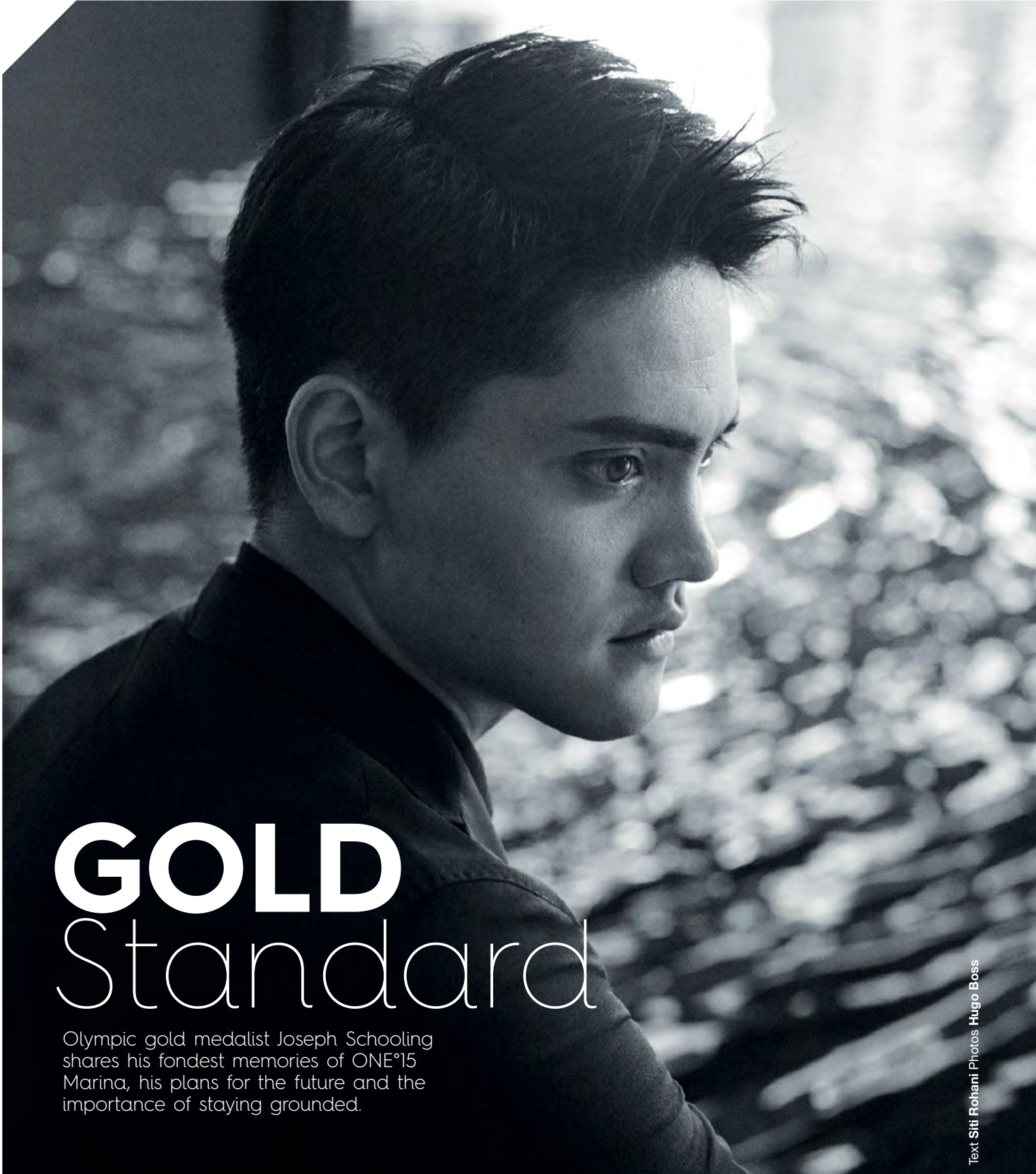

SeaKeepers Asia was identified for this project because its motto, *Research. Educate. Protect and Restore*, aligns with our aim to raise awareness on the importance of sustainability as key to cleaner waters and maintaining a thriving marine eco-system.

We are also inspired by the organisation's active role in living up to its motto. In March, it brought volunteer divers to Redang Island Marine Park in Terengganu, Malaysia to remove marine debris, plant rescued coral nubbins on bases before relocating them to a coral nursery to safeguard and encourage survival of the broken corals. To celebrate World Oceans Day on 10 June, it teamed up with NUS Scientists and other partners, and sent divers to pick up marine trash at Sisters' Islands Marine Park.

"As a marine conservation group that was founded 20 years ago by a group of concerned yacht owners, we are delighted to partner with ONE°15 Marina to set up the Coral Garden," says Julian Chang, The International SeaKeepers Society, Asia President and Board Member. "We are actively involved in projects that promote education, research, protection and restoration of our oceans and marine life, and this is an ideal platform to do just that, as well as to contribute to the future of Singapore's marine biodiversity." 



GOLD Standard

Olympic gold medalist Joseph Schooling shares his fondest memories of ONE°15 Marina, his plans for the future and the importance of staying grounded.

It has been two years since he won the gold medal for the 100m butterfly at the 2016 Rio Olympic Games, but Joseph Isaac Schooling can still recall the excitement of the win. “There were so many emotions going through my mind. I don’t really remember much from the race itself, as I was preoccupied in the zone. All I remember is finishing and touching the wall, then looking back to see my time and just going crazy. That was probably one of the best feelings I’ve ever experienced,” he says.

Since that historic win—Singapore’s first ever Olympic gold medal—Schooling’s form has taken a bit of a tumble, with a bronze showing at the FINA World Championships a year later and several disappointing finishes at his collegiate meets. However, the champion is not sweating it.

“For the most part of my career, I was always trying to surpass some athletes,” he shares. “And now that others are trying to get me down, I have to change my mentality. I have to find a different source of motivation to stay competitive and keep wanting more. I think I had a problem with that last year because I was so used to my old mindset that I had to take a step back. It’s about trial and error, and right now I think I’m coming to a very good balance of longevity in the sport.”

Schooling thrives in the pressure that comes from being a world-class athlete. “Pressure is good; pressure is what keeps me going,” he says. However, he depends on his parents, Colin and May Schooling, as well as his best friends to keep him grounded.

“I’ve seen how others act when they’re in the spotlight and I always tell myself that I am not that kind of person. The most important thing is to be grounded and to keep your head up while working towards your goals. In the pool, I have to be cocky. If you don’t think you’re the best, then you’re not going to be the best. But that doesn’t mean you have to be an arrogant and cocky guy out of the pool,” he says.

The 23-year-old turned professional in March this year, which means he can now work with brands and sponsors. Some of the brands he is involved with include DBS, TAG Heuer and Hugo Boss. When asked how he chooses the brands he wants to work with, he reveals that the brand’s values have to be aligned to his personal values.

He finds the world of entertainment and fashion—one that he’s now also a part of—very different from the swimming world. “It’s a different

feel for sure, but I like it precisely because it’s different. I embrace change and I like to experience new things. I’m not someone who just goes with the flow,” he says.

Schooling is also an ambassador for ONE°15 Marina, a role he has held since 2016. He fondly remembers his first visit to the Club, when he was invited on stage by the CEO and Chairman of SUTL Enterprise, Mr Arthur Tay, and got a chance to meet other Members. In June, Schooling had another unforgettable experience at the Club when he hosted his birthday party onboard a yacht. “It was one of my best birthdays to date—a great boat, great people, great atmosphere,” he shares.

The economics major, who describes himself as laid back, is currently finishing his final semester at the University of Texas. He admits he would rather “chill at home” than head out to a lively party. In fact, his idea of a perfect day is just staying put. “Sleeping in until 11am, rolling around in bed until noon, eating right after that from 12 to 1pm, going for lunch around 3pm, then catching a movie, and finally coming back by 9pm to get ready for practice the next day.”

Those days don’t come by often as he’s usually in the pool for practice for up to eight hours a day. As for his future plans, Schooling says he’s preparing himself for upcoming competitions, such as the 2018 Asian Games in Jakarta and Palembang, next year’s SEA Games in the Philippines, as well as the Olympic Games in Tokyo in 2020.

Despite experiencing the gruelling highs and lows in recent years, Schooling seems content with where he is at the moment: “I’m very happy with where my career is. There’s something to look forward to every day, and that makes me happy.”

Service WITH A Smile

As ONE°15's Front Office Manager, Lianah Yatim understands how to make guests feel special. She shares the secret to good service with *Longitude*.

Lianah believes that empowering staff to make independent decisions can have a positive impact on guests' experience at the Club.

LONGITUDE: Welcome to the ONE°15 Marina family. How are you finding work so far Lianah?

Front Office Manager Lianah Yatim (LY): Thanks! I've been in the service industry for 18 years—I used to be a Singapore Airlines cabin crew member, as well as a guest relations officer and front office manager at several hotels. Here at ONE°15 Marina, I oversee the Front Office department. I thought it was going to be easier to manage the 26 rooms we have at the Club, but I've since found out that it's not. In fact, more attention is needed here compared to a 500-room hotel.

With all the training you had, how do you ensure that guests have a positive experience?

LY: At ONE°15 Marina, it is our goal to make every guest feel at home by injecting a personal touch in our service. We establish a connection with the guest by accompanying them to their rooms and to the driveway when they leave the club. These little pockets of time are windows for us to create a lasting impression on our guests.

One thing I've learned is that one size doesn't fit all. We have to customise guest experiences based on the type of traveller they are. For example, business travellers appreciate prompt service. At a previous work place, when a guest's luggage didn't arrive on time, I gave him a corporate polo tee, a new pair of socks and a few other personal items to use while waiting for his bag to arrive. He was very appreciative of that.

That was very thoughtful of you. How many people does it take to to run a successful Front Office at ONE°15 Marina?

LY: There are seven people in the department, including myself. We manage the check-ins and check-outs, answer all Members' enquiries, greet Members when they arrive at the Club and handle all requests that come our way. The front office is the heart of the Club and the place where Members and guests experience the warmth of the ONE°15 hospitality.

What skills are important for your role?

LY: You need to be able to build relationships and connect with people easily, whether with fellow team members or guests. When you connect with people, you become better at understanding their wants and needs.

What do you appreciate most about working here?

LY: I love that I am able to bring in fresh ideas, which wasn't quite possible for me to do at other hotel chains as they are very structured and have strict guidelines to be followed. I also appreciate the people here, as well

as the teamwork and support that I get from other departments.

What makes you good at your job?

LY: I'm very detail-oriented and I truly care about the guests plus I also understand the staff's point of view. For instance, a couple checked in recently and requested for an extra bed as they have a young child. However, they didn't use the extra bed in the end. A staff member asked me if we should waive the charge for the extra bed. I told her to decide since she was the one in touch with the guest. I believe that when staff are empowered to make independent decisions, guests will feel the impact.

Any challenges you had to deal with since you joined?

LY: Since we only have 26 rooms, I feel we can and should get to know every guest intimately. As such, I make it a personal goal to help our guests build fond memories of ONE°15 Marina. It can be as simple as a smooth check in, a welcome drink upon arrival or helping them plan and execute a birthday surprise. The challenge is to impress personal touches upon every guest and exceed the current service standard.

What's the best part about working at the Club?

LY: You smell the sea breeze and a hint of suntan lotion—it feels like I'm on a beach holiday every day! I even told my husband that I feel like I'm going to a resort vacation instead of working. I don't think I will ever get tired of the marina view, either.

How would you describe yourself in three words?

LY: Candid, conscientious and logical. 🍷

3. Desserts

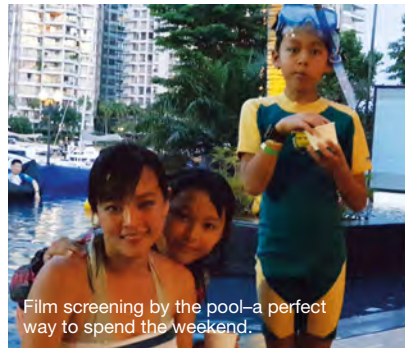
I love cakes—they are my weakness. That's why I walk so much, to offset all the calories from the cakes I eat.



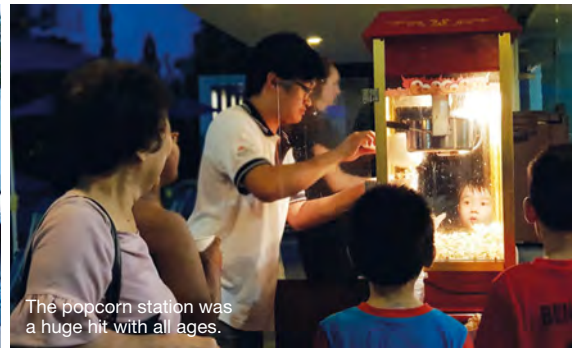

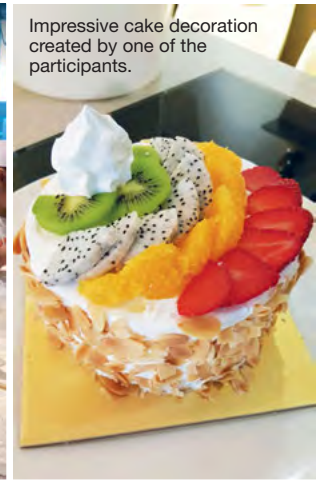
The Club also provided delicious snacks such as freshly made popcorn on both days for Members to munch on as they enjoyed the movie screenings. 🍿

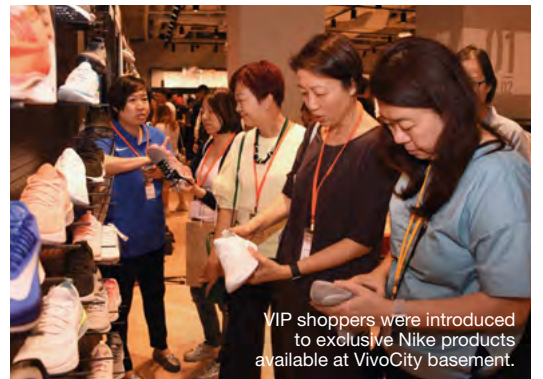

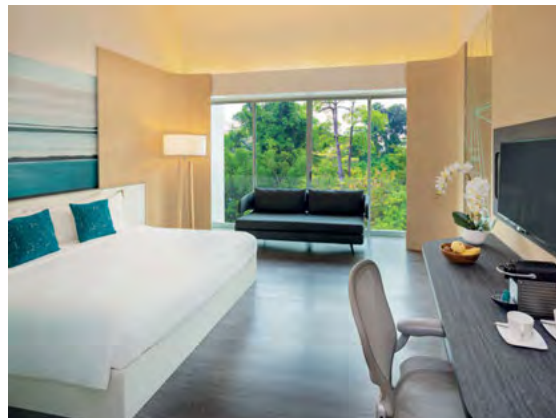

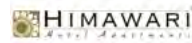

THE Perfect CURE

More than just an ancient craft, the tradition of curing meats lives on beyond time and space.

The wonderful thing about meat is its ability to transform into entirely different entities on the plate. The quickest way to steady your hunger is to catch a beast, slaughter it, and toss it on the grill. In five minutes, steak is served. The pleasure is immediate. But good things, as they say, come to those who wait. A slither of jamón Ibérico takes two years—sometimes three—to go from porcine to divine, and the transformation takes place in a hidden language that only *charcutiers* and *salumieres* can decipher.

The art of curing meat is really a science. And it's not a modern science. It represents some of the oldest methods of cooking and preservation. Drying, salting, smoking all came before the cool convenience of the refrigerator. While the baptism of fire transforms a slab of meat into something blue, medium rare, or well-done, curing it presents a panorama of possibilities. Here, a pig is not just pork. It manifests as pancetta, lardo, prosciutto, soppressata, coppa, and salami all at once. It is infinitely varied. Uniformly delicious.

The process of curing a piece of meat doesn't merely begin with the drying and ageing. Terroir is equally important and sense of place becomes a magnificent thing. The breed of the beast, the food it grazes on, the lay of the land—these beginnings are as important as the end. Technically, it is possible for you to cure your own meat in Singapore. But would it taste as good? Probably not.

Over a decade ago, you would be hard-pressed to find jamón Ibérico in tapas bars here. It was only in 2008 that the Agri-Food and Veterinary Authority finally approved the import of this delicacy into Singapore. Today, no self-respecting Spanish tapas bar or restaurant would be seen without a leg of jamón resting on its counters. And it is not just Spanish cured meats that are making their way to our shores. French, Italian, and even Hungarian producers are likewise helping to expand our vocabulary in the delicatessen wing.

Cured meats run the gamut, from the mellow and creamy to the rich and spicy. Here are some to tickle the palate and plate the platter.



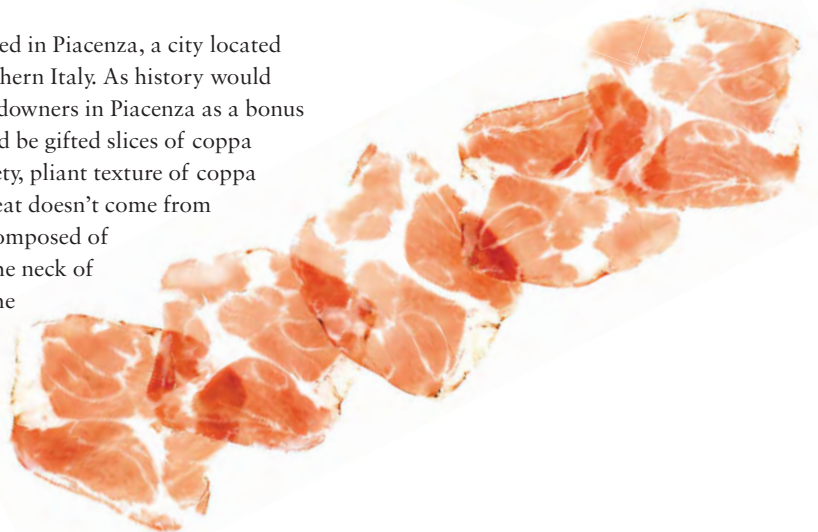
PROSCIUTTO DI PARMA

Otherwise known as Parma ham, prosciutto di Parma comes from pigs raised and cured in the province of Parma, Italy. Unlike most cured meats, prosciutto di Parma does not contain spices, sugar or additives. Instead, salt is massaged into the hind legs of the hog before it is left to dry and aged over a period of 10 to 36 months. The hogs in question are raised on a diet of grains and whey from cheese factories that produce the region's famed Parmesan cheese, and it is for this reason that you'll find the meat perfumed with an earthy, nutty flavour. If you're tired of the classic prosciutto and melon pairing, try having the meat with pomegranate or avocado. As pre-sliced prosciutto oxidises quickly, it should be consumed within a day or two.



COPPA

The practice of curing coppa originated in Piacenza, a city located in the Emilia Romagna region of northern Italy. As history would have it, coppa was once touted by landowners in Piacenza as a bonus of sorts. Industrious field hands would be gifted slices of coppa in return for their toil. While the velvety, pliant texture of coppa is similar to that of prosciutto, the meat doesn't come from the hind leg of the hog. Instead, it's composed of chunks of pork—typically cut from the neck of the pig—stuffed into large casings. The meat is cured with salt, wine, and a spice mix that's either spicy or sweet. The rich, earthy flavours of coppa are best savoured when the meat is sliced paper-thin.



WINTER SALAMI

With a history dating back to 1869, the production of winter salami is a proud tradition upheld by Pick Szeged, a Hungarian purveyor of various meat products. While the original recipe called for donkey meat, the modern-day version has been tweaked to yield a mixture of lean pork and pork belly. Until today, the spices that go into the mix remain a well-kept secret but what we do know is that the meat is smoked over beech wood and left to mature for up to a hundred days in cold air. At the end of its journey, the winter salami develops its signature coat of white mould. This coating acts as a shield to prevent the salami from turning rancid, thus prolonging its shelf life.

JAMÓN IBÉRICO DE BELLOTA

This coveted delicacy can retail for as much as \$200 per kilogramme, arguably a small sum to pay for its intense, layered, earthy and nutty flavours. Its gleaming, crimson flesh is delicately marbled with fat that melts on the tongue, and the only way to do justice to this exquisite treat is to savour it au naturel and unembellished.

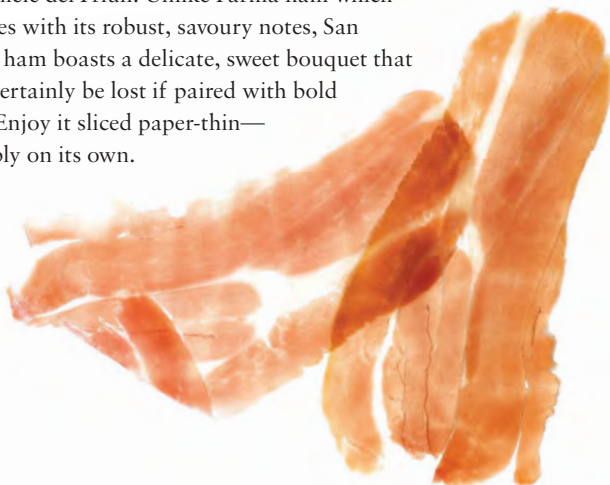
Only Iberico pigs—distinguished by their black hooves—are destined to become jamón Ibérico de bellota. Their lives before the slaughter is almost enviable: they wander freely in green pastures, grazing on acorns, wild grass and herbs.

Once slaughtered, the legs of the pigs are crusted in sea salt before they are left to cure in cool mountain air—a process that could take anywhere from 14 to 36 months.



PROSCIUTTO DI SAN DANIELE

Similar to prosciutto di Parma, prosciutto di San Daniele is produced with only salt, sans preservatives. Once again, provenance and terroir play a principal role in imbuing the meat with its unique taste profile. The pigs hail from farms in 10 specific regions of central northern Italy while the curing process takes place exclusively in San Daniele del Friuli. Unlike Parma ham which impresses with its robust, savoury notes, San Daniele ham boasts a delicate, sweet bouquet that would certainly be lost if paired with bold dishes. Enjoy it sliced paper-thin—preferably on its own.



CHORIZO DE PAMPLONA

Simply put, a salami is composed of the trim left from butchering an animal, then mixed in with a good dollop of fat before the mixture is seasoned, ground, stuffed into casings, and hung to dry. From here, countless variations of salami can be made. The meat can be coarsely or finely ground before a cocktail of seasonings is applied. With the chorizo de Pamplona, one finds a finely ground mixture of pork, beef, and pork fat marinated with salt, pimento (otherwise known as paprika), garlic and sugar. This reddish-orange meat is a favourite in the Basque Country and impresses with its rich and spicy flavours. Balance its heat by sautéing and sprinkling the salami over eggs, tossing into a stew, or simply paired with sweet and mellow Manchego cheese. 🍷



A TASTE OF ITALY

If you're craving for Parma ham, make your way to LATITUDE Bistro and order the signature Parma Pizza. Topped with arugula and cheese, this 12-inch pizza comes with a thin crust and is perfect for sharing over a pint of beer or a glass of wine.

PAN-FRIED LATINO CHICKEN (BONELESS)

4 PORTIONS

INGREDIENTS

- 1kg of chicken whole leg, boneless
- 1 onion, chopped
- 2 cloves of garlic, chopped
- 10g of ginger, chopped
- 1 chilli, chopped
- 1 teaspoon of All Spice
- 2 teaspoons of fresh thyme
- 1 teaspoon of black pepper, crushed
- 1 lime, juiced
- Salt and pepper to taste
- Oil for cooking

- Marinate the boneless chicken overnight
- Add cooking oil to frying pan, medium heat
- Sear both sides of the chicken and continue cooking over low heat until the chicken is cooked completely.
- Serve with seasonal vegetables

A NEW **wave**

A magnet for surfers and travellers seeking a languid beachside retreat, Canggu, a small village close to Seminyak, has quietly emerged as Bali's newest hotspot. Here's our edit of places to discover in this up-and-coming creative enclave.

Como Uma Canggu

Bali is known for many things—its abundance of culturally-rich religious sites, forested volcanic mountains, beaches with spectacular coral reefs, and an endless stream of resorts and retreats vying for a share of the tourist population. This new property in the tropical paradise, however, isn't competing with luxury players in Seminyak or Ubud, but in Canggu, a destination fast becoming a favourite among expatriates and surfers.

With two other properties in Bali—Como Shambhala Estate, the luxury hotel group's flagship wellness retreat; and Como Uma Ubud, a rustic resort nestled in the tropical jungle—Como adopts a distinctly different approach towards Como Uma Canggu, catering to the village's vibrant scene of digital nomads and beach lovers. The result? A cosmopolitan melting pot that borrows from modern Asian and European design principles.

The work of long-time collaborators Koichiro Ikebuchi (Como Shambhala and Como Uma Ubud) and Paola Navone (Como Point Yamu in Phuket and Como Metropolitan Miami Beach), Como Uma Canggu's interior design is a combination of Japanese minimalism and Italian sophistication, with a nod to Balinese philosophy, which seeks harmony with nature.



Nature plays a big part in the resort's architecture, expertly designed and integrated into both indoor and outdoor spaces by landscape architect Trevor Hillier. Tropical flora and shrubbery dot the property and adorn the balconies, breathing life into the timber and concrete structure; almost all the residences offer panoramic views of the Indian Ocean from their private balconies. Outside, the sprawling lawns are perfectly in tune with the laid-back vibe of Canggu.

At Como Uma Canggu, the minimalist interior seamlessly extends into the lush outdoors offering guests an immersion with nature.

The Slow

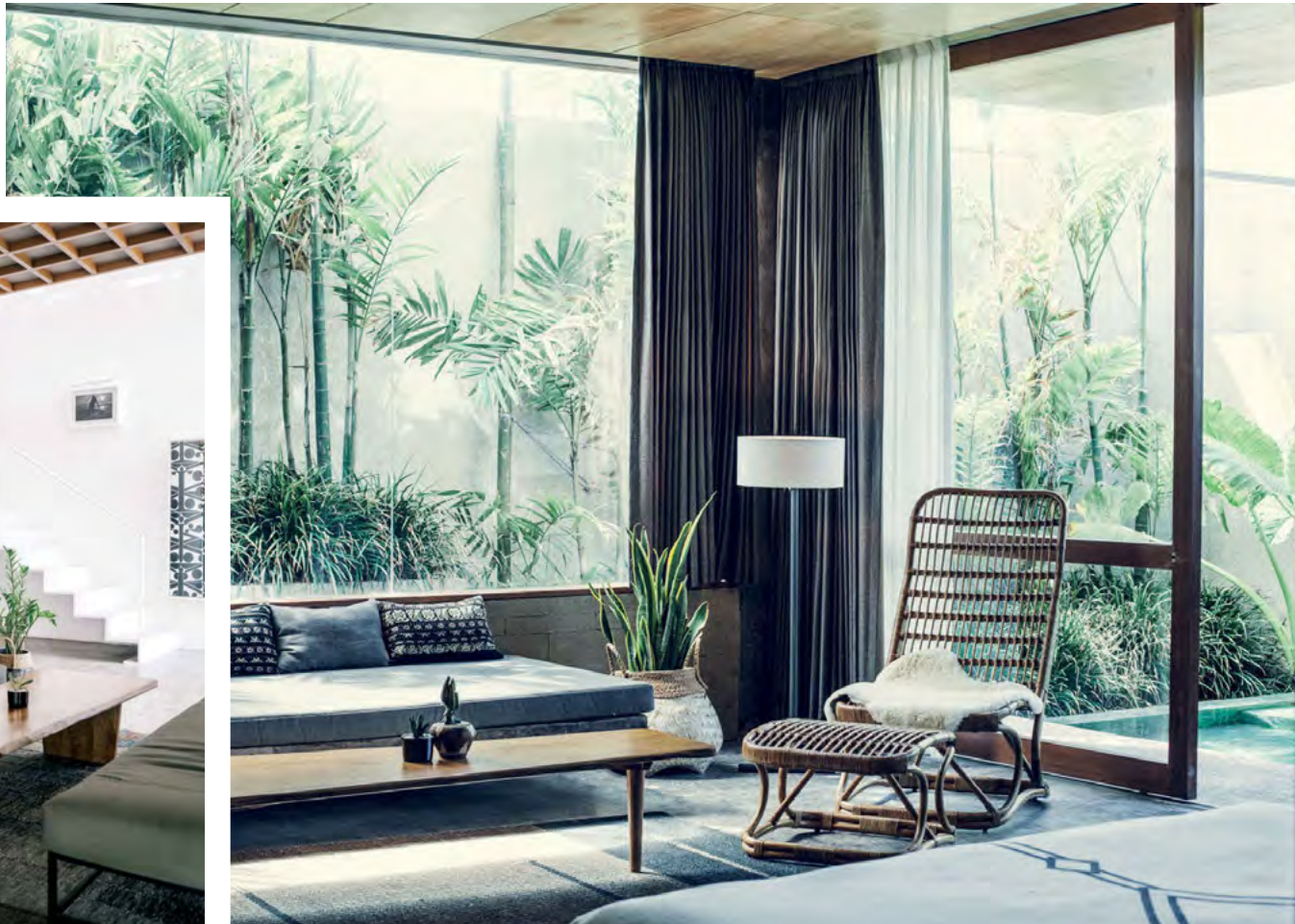
To cast The Slow, a recent addition to Canggu's ever-expanding boho-chic scene, as just a hotel is to do it a huge disservice. This multi-layered beachside getaway has cool accommodation, all-day dining and drinks, myriad art initiatives as well as its own retail outlet. Crafted by director-designer George Garrow and his wife, model Cisco Tschurtschenthaler, the hotel pulls off the trick of being hip, rustic, modern, cosy and industrial all at once—a feat it accomplishes with buckets of style.

The couple's imprimatur touches upon all facets of the resort, from the ceramics designed by Cisco to the Non-Type store, masterminded by George. The resort has a look best described as tropical brutalism, softened by locally artisan-produced furniture, textiles and crafts. Suites espouse clean lines with floor-to-ceiling windows and screens that swivel open to frame views of the village and the pool suites are swathed in verdant landscaping and come with private plunge pools.

Meals at its restaurant, Eat & Drink, focus on the three S's—seasonality, sustainability and sane eating—with dishes that include wood-grilled meat and seafood, local vegetables, farm greens and field grains. The restaurant's interiors are made for the Instagram generation, with botanical chandeliers, lattice wood walls and eye-catching seating, while the rooftop is a gorgeous spot for a drink at sunset and a chance to reflect on the day's pleasures.

Equally as exciting is the owner's personal art collection that appears throughout the property, including 90 pieces of photography and sculpture, some of which were commissioned especially for the hotel. "Most of the pieces are from close friends," says Garrow. "There are stories behind these artworks—each hangs with a reason and represents a time in our lives. There are walls in The Slow that take me back to a time when I got a kick up the ass and felt creatively inspired to reach a little higher and go a little deeper."

The Slow exudes a meticulously crafted haute-fashion-meets-surfer-cool atmosphere.



EAT + DRINK

Two Trees Eatery

There's a certain poetic beauty to the story behind this eatery. The owners grew up in the same town in southwest France, only meeting by chance when they moved to Bali, where they decided to open a restaurant with two trees in front to symbolise their serendipitous union. The restaurant offers healthy food, served with nuts and seeds that aid digestion, as well as locally produced ham and cheese. Everything is housed in a verdant setting that proffers a soothing, natural ambience.

The Lawn

A place that lures the local glitterati, this beach club features a restaurant, a bar, a pool and daybeds, decks galore and—as the name suggests—a large lawn with palm trees, straw mats, cushions and umbrellas, making it the ideal locale for the art of relaxation. Its top deck, with views from Tanah Lot in the north to Uluwatu in the south, is sublime for sunset drinks.

Da Maria

This modern osteria also doubles up as a late-night pizza bar and disco. The interiors meld Bali with Rome, from the ubiquitous passionfruit vines to Pantheon-inspired skylights, fountains featuring geometric blue and white tiles, and chandeliers with unfussy festoon lighting reminiscent of 1960s Italian courtyard restaurants. Chairs and tables are an expression of the French *fer forgé* (wrought iron) style.

SHOP + RELAX

Spring Spa

This wellness centre offers yoga, meditation, hairdressing, manicures and other beauty treatments in contemporary surrounds. Its interior features a soft neutral palette, paired with a travertine reception desk and textured limestone walls. The ceiling is notable for its 1,000 bamboo stalks, while the custom furniture and cabinetry are made with natural materials from local suppliers, lending the spa a sense of place. The open, airy walkways feature organic plantings and a huge freshwater pond that stretches the length of the complex.

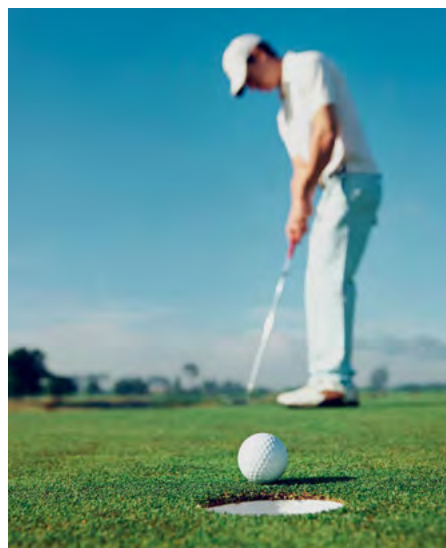
