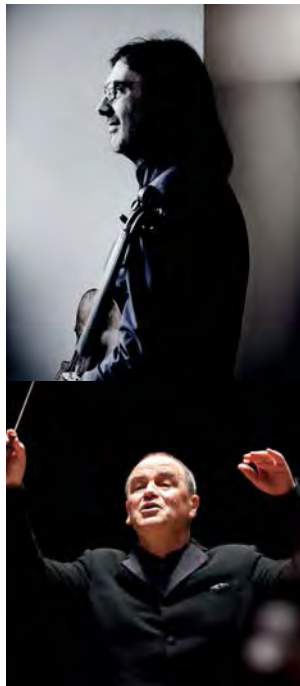
The Importance of Being Earnest

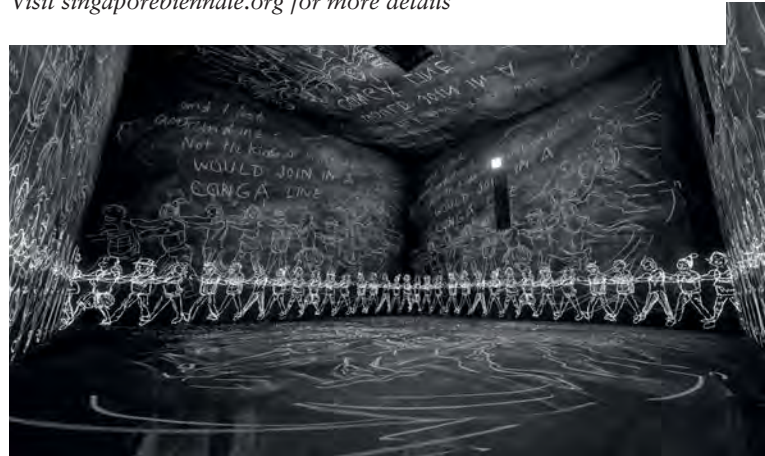
M1 Singapore Fringe Festival

SAILING TO NEW HORIZONS

From porter to deputy general manager, global citizen Sabrina Lei Shi has turned obstacles into important life lessons.

A world of experience, cultural exposure and determination to succeed, are but some of the qualifications of Sabrina Lei Shi.

As we sit chatting at Bar Nebula on a late Friday afternoon, Sabrina Lei Shi's mobile chimes away ceaselessly. Each is a work call or message, requiring her attention. As Deputy General Manager of ONE°15 Marina Sentosa Cove, Shi is involved in every aspect of the running of the marina. She filters through daily revenue reports, works on business forecasts, analyses industry trends, and oversees the day-to-day operations of the Club.

It is hard to tell that Shi had only been with the Club for six weeks at the point of writing. The hospitality veteran addresses each decision firmly and with laser-focus. What's even more surprising is that the industry was never on her radar—her dream was to be a ballet dancer.

The Road Less Travelled

"At the age of 10, I was talent spotted and picked for a government-run ballet institution in China. Training was intense—we practised seven hours a day," she recalls. But the competitive nature in Shi pushed her to master the steps faster, and train an additional three hours each day. She ended up tearing a ligament in her leg when she was 11.

This accident put an abrupt end to her dancing career. At the age of 16, Shi left the institute to focus on her studies. Her first job upon graduation was on board a cruise ship—which laid the path for her multi-city hospitality career.

The English language, however, proved to be a barrier for the native Shanghainese, especially when it was spoken in different accents. She overcame that hurdle as well by spending all her free time—even after gruelling 10-hour shifts—memorising the English dictionary, and making conversation with guests to practise.

Her love for travel and exploring different cultures coupled with the grit for taking risks saw Shi relocate many a time in search of new challenges. She moved on from her cruise-ship stint to the role of spa manager at Ringha, Shangri-La, Tibet, where she helped set up the business.

At the age of 28, the Down Under came calling. But the globetrotter found herself lacking the required hospitality experience in Australia. Then, Shi did something that shocked most of her peers—she gamely took a major demotion from spa manager to hotel porter.

"It was a life-changing and humbling experience. It taught me to be down-to-earth and adaptable. It also helped me build a very strong foundation in hospitality, which is very important," she says. Sure enough, the next 14 years saw Shi climbing up the corporate ladder. She was Executive Assistant Hotel Manager with TFE Hotel Group in Australia for three years before Singapore came calling. Today, the 42-year-old is second-in-command at the Club.

As a Chinese woman who has broken what many may perceive to be invisible glass ceilings, Shi credits her success to the many mentors she met during her career. "I've learnt that being a good leader is not necessarily the same thing as simply being a nice person. A good leader should be able to lead decisively and by example, and also help his or her team members grow meaningfully," she reflects.

"I used to be a very black-and-white sort of person, over the years, I've also learnt the value of

adding a softer touch," she says. She also learnt to play a more supportive role in the Club.

Her vast exposure and international perspective also enables her to anticipate the needs of guests and offer tailored experiences. "Luxury today is very customised—you have to understand a person's culture. You cannot just give everyone the same recommendation," she explains.

When not working, Shi loves making pottery. "I am a very hands-on person and I love the arts. To make good pottery, I believe you need to be very focused and detail oriented. It's the same with work—if you are passionate about something, you will find your focus to excel at it," says the gritty Deputy General Manager, whose vision is to build the business at ONE°15 and make it Asia's and the world's finest marina. 🍷

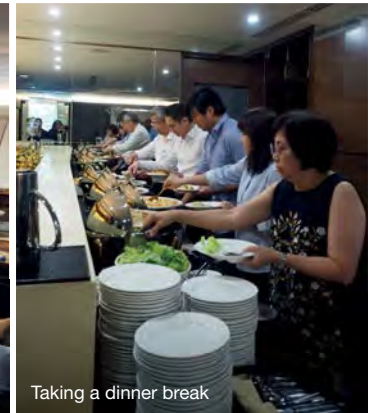
DATA SECURITY TALK

FORTUNE'S FLAVOURS

Indulge in a celebratory feast this Chinese New Year at WOK°15 Kitchen with the season's most fortuitous ingredients.

Reunion dinners typically entail sumptuous feasts that are not only delicious, but feature an array of foods that are considered “lucky” in Chinese culture. Many of these ingredients are loaded with symbolic significance, and eating them is thought to bring a multitude of blessings such as wealth, good health, smooth business dealings and even a baby or two! It's also common for the names of these foods to sound like favourable words, says Chef William Soh of WOK°15 Kitchen at ONE°15 Marina Sentosa Cove. A seasoned veteran in curating festive feasts, Chef Soh has prepared three exquisite eight-course Chinese New Year menus that are available from 18 January to 9 February at WOK°15 Kitchen. Here, he shares his pick of auspicious Chinese New Year foods and how best to enjoy them.



Yusheng

Everyone knows that chicken rice may be Singapore's most iconic dish, but fewer know that yusheng ("raw fish" in Mandarin) was also created on local shores. Said to have been invented in the 1960s by four Cantonese chefs who were popularly known as the Four Heavenly Kings, yusheng is a colourful "salad" comprising finely shaved vegetables (such as carrot, radish and cucumber), raw fish, and assorted condiments such as deep-fried wonton skin, plum sauce and peanuts. Yusheng is probably the only food you're encouraged to play with—diners usually toss it as high as they can while shouting auspicious well-wishes for the new year. Each of WOK15 Kitchen's celebratory menus start with this well-loved dish—the flavoursome addition of crunchy, crispy deep-fried fish skin makes it a particular treat.





Black Moss

Despite its seaweed-like appearance, black moss, or fa cai, grows in desert areas. Dried, it resembles a tangle of fine black hair, hence its name, fa cai, which means “hair vegetable”, which also sounds like “strike it rich” in Chinese. Fa cai “symbolises good fortune”, says Chef Soh of the delicacy, which is so popular in Singapore that at the height of its popularity, 800kg of it was imported here in 2013, according to the Agri-Food & Veterinary Authority of Singapore. Typically added to hot pots, or cooked in saucy preparations with meat and vegetables, fa cai is usually soaked in water prior to cooking, which gives it an appealingly smooth, vermicelli-like texture.



Prawns

Prawns are associated with the idea of joy and happiness, and the Cantonese word for prawn even sounds like laughter. Eating them as part of a balanced diet is good for you: while they are relatively high in dietary cholesterol, prawns provide key nutrients, are protein-rich and are low in saturated fat and calories. They are also utterly delicious, lending themselves to a wide variety of preparation styles.

“Prawns eaten during Chinese New Year celebrations are almost always served whole, with their heads and tails preserved, symbolising the completeness of life,” adds Chef Soh, who features the crustacean prominently in WOK°15 Kitchen’s celebratory feasts, where they’re delicately poached in Chinese wine or cooked in Singapore-style chilli sauce.

Chicken

“A whole chicken is usually served during Chinese New Year to represent family togetherness and to celebrate a year of good harvests,” says Chef Soh, who roasts the chicken until its skin is shatteringly crisp and its meat mouthwateringly moist. A good source of protein, chicken also symbolises abundance as a whole bird can feed all the family if prepared correctly.





Fish

“A whole fish is a staple of Chinese New Year celebrations, and is intended to welcome prosperity for the entire year,” says Chef Soh. In Mandarin, the word for “surplus” is a homophone of “fish”. Each fish is typically served whole—with the head and tail attached—to symbolise a good beginning and ending for the year. Only the freshest of fish will do for reunion dinners, and as such steaming is a popular option for chefs who want to showcase their ingredients’ ultra-fresh texture and flavours. WOK°15 Kitchen offers diners two enticing options: The delicate flavours of Steamed Live Marble Goby with Light Soya Sauce or Deep Fried Marble Goby with Deluxe Soya Sauce.



Dessert

Save the best for last—conclude your reunion dinner with the sweetest of endings, or traditional Chinese desserts, to be precise. These can include red date cakes, osmanthus jelly or almond cookies and assure a smooth and blissful year ahead. WOK°15 Kitchen offers the perennial favourite, Mango with Pomelo and Sago, as well as a delightful concoction of Chilled Peach Gum with Red Dates and Snow Fungus. Peach gum, a resin harvested from peach trees, is particularly delicious—the amber-hued gum is high in collagen and has a pleasantly chewy bite reminiscent of bird's nest.

- 10g garlic, peeled and chopped
- 150ml tomato ketchup
- 30ml chilli sauce
- 5 pieces calamansi (small limes)
- Coriander leaves (for garnish)
- Cornflour (mixed with water for thickening)
- Salt, pepper and sugar (to taste)

METHOD

- Wash and deshell prawns, keeping heads and tails intact.
- Place in steamer and cook for about 3 to 4 minutes. Set aside.
- Add garlic, onions and ginger to a hot cooking pan and sauté evenly.
- Stir in tomato ketchup and chilli sauce. Continue cooking and stirring for 2 to 3 more minutes. Add juice from calamansi limes.
- Add the prawns and adjust seasoning.
- Thicken with cornflour. Arrange neatly on dinner plate.
- Garnish with coriander leaves.

Maharajas' Express' Indian Splendour

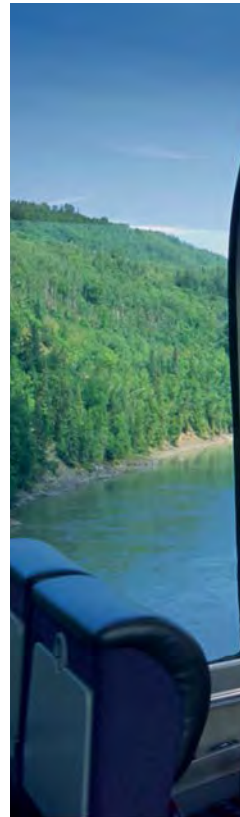
