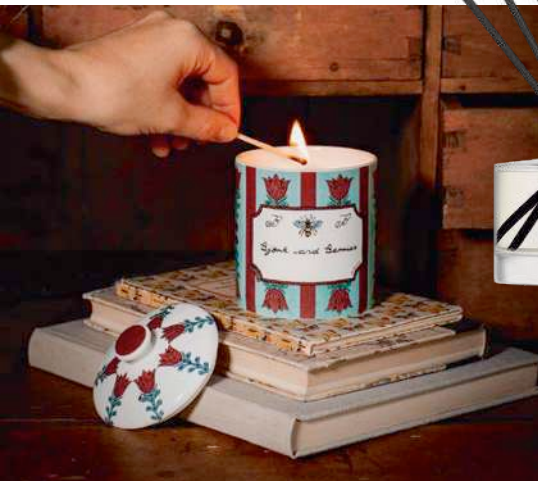

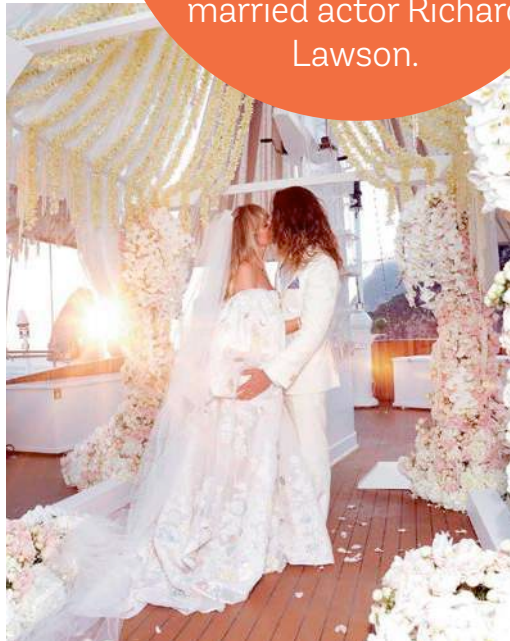

SECURITY COMPANY OWNER FRANCO PESCI'S DECISION TO MOVE TO SINGAPORE WAS LED BY HIS LOVE FOR ADVENTURE AND FAMILY.

Francisco Pesci looks at ease in ONE°15 Marina Sentosa Cove—the CEO of security sales consultancy YEM is also clearly in his happy place, as his wife Valentina and son Tobey are by his side.

We had just 40 minutes to chat as the entrepreneur needed to take a call, but it was enough time to see how tight-knit the family is.

“This is something that people do not know about me,” starts Pesci. “They see me as an extrovert, who likes to enjoy life. But I am very much a family guy. When my wife and son were away recently for 10 weeks, it was challenging,” he adds in earnest.

Born in Bologna, Italy, Pesci first travelled to Asia as a 25-year-old. “My love of Asia started in Shanghai. I flew there with work every month in my role as an export manager. The city felt frenetic and was buzzing with innovation,” he says. But it was Singapore that allowed him to harness his love for family—it’s where he got married and his son was born—and fuelled his entrepreneurial spirit. He brought his security sales consultancy YEM to Singapore from Italy, helping security manufacturers penetrate Southeast Asian markets.

BACK TO HIS ROOTS

“I find Singapore a much safer hub for doing business,” he says, although the pandemic has thrown in a very different set of challenges. But he was ready to meet them head on and pivoted his business model. As his Singapore experts couldn’t travel, he employed more people on the ground in different countries in Southeast Asia to assist his team and clients. This gave his clients the much-needed face-to-face support.

He is equally committed to the families of his employees. “I work to create wealth for me, my family and of course, for all the families of my employees because they count on me,” he says.



It was the needs of his own family that encouraged him to become a Member at ONE°15 Marina Sentosa Cove—chiefly to give his tennis-playing son a place to practise. The Club also gave Pesci a chance to return to the water.

As a young boy, Pesci had spent many years on the Adriatic Coast with his late father on his fishing boat. “We would sail along the Adriatic Sea, around Sicily and Croatia,” he says. “When I close my eyes, I can still see the sapphire blue sea. There was no pollution back then, it was amazing.”

The father and son would spend hours on the water fishing. “Our best catch was when I was 10 years old—we caught a 365-kg bluefin tuna. My father was the angler and I was the skipper. It took us six hours to get the fish on board,” says Pesci, adding

that the memory of it makes him cry even today.

Embracing the shoreside life was Pesci’s way of giving his own son a taste of the childhood experiences he had. The pandemic also spurred him to get his sailing licence in Singapore—he got his first one at the age of 18 in Italy—although he is yet to take the plunge and own a boat—the family has been chartering yachts to St John’s island and others.

ONWARDS ALWAYS

Although Pesci says he enjoys the quiet life, his work shows no signs of slowing down. He has since launched Mukiku, a digital marketing company, so named by Tobey, and is now about to launch his third brand. While three companies on the surface may seem unwieldy, Pesci said he designed them such that they all interconnect—with shared specialities.

Now, having brought an enterprising Singaporean general manager on board, he is enjoying focusing on being the CEO. “I like it to see my ideas taking shape. This is what I really love,” said Pesci.

Despite the times, Pesci remains positive. “There are a lot of outstanding opportunities in Southeast Asia. If you have the right team, with the right channels and connection who speaks the language of the country, you can find them.”

Besides, with his everyday beginning right, he is confident he can do more. “I love the smile on my son’s face when he says *buongiorno* to us each morning. I love starting my day with that.” ☒

RIDING THE WAVE

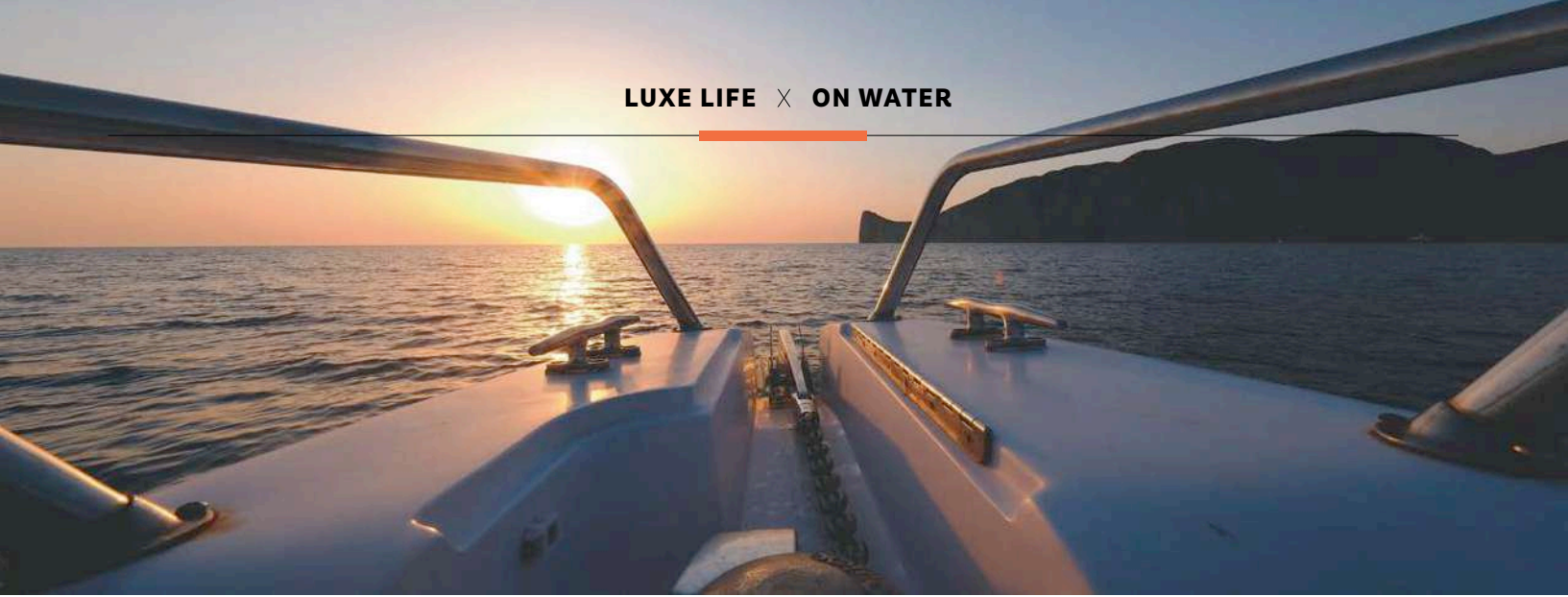
Captain Jose Molina Salinas grew up in Majorca, Spain, amidst picturesque islands and aquamarine waters. He arrived in Singapore in March last year as skipper of 93-ft long ranger superyacht *Sea Forever*, which made its way to Asia later that year in May. The objective of this long distance trip was to explore the region and make the most of what the vessel had to offer—“it can cross half the world, and sail across the Pacific or Atlantic ocean on a full tank and without any support”, says Captain Salinas. Ideal as she is for cruising along Southeast Asian islands, COVID-19 has put a dampener on *Sea Forever’s* plans, and she has remained berthed at ONE°15 Marina Sentosa Cove. Nevertheless Captain Salinas and his crew, which includes his chef wife and stewardess, remain busy keeping the yacht in shape and being on top of all its maintenance.

We had a chat with Captain Salinas in the midst of his busy schedule.

How did you get into the yachting industry?

I came to this industry by accident. Although I grew up around the water, sailing was never on my radar and I explored many other professions. In 1994, when I finished mandatory military service, I was unsure about what I wanted to do with my life. My mother then introduced me to her friend who was in the boating business—he looked after the sail boats of people from the UK and Germany who had a second residence in Majorca. I started my yachting career on ground, washing, polishing and painting these boats, before I started going out on sea trails to deliver boats from one port to another. That’s when I realised how beautiful it was out there. I love the water—I have been around it all my life—but until then I had never entertained the thought of working at sea.





How have your early experiences shaped you?

I grew up in a village and come from humble beginnings—my father was a plumber and my mother, a babysitter. So there was no one in my family who had aspirations of going to sea. My boss—my mother's friend—was an experienced seaman and a very good teacher. I learnt a lot from him. Under him, I developed an interest in sailing and decided to make it my career. I went on to acquire a few licenses, and after a few years I started skippering between the Balearic islands before moving to bigger yachts, and now here I am with a long range superyacht. I really am enjoying every bit of my work.

Which among the places you have visited is your favourite?

My boss is a man of adventure so with the yacht we keep in Majorca we have sailed all over, from New York to the Virgin Islands and the Bahamas—which was the most memorable one for me. There are more than 7,000 islands in the Bahamas—which is impossible to cover even if you make multiple trips—so we chose Exuma. The moment we anchored near one of the smaller islands, we could see dark spots towards the boat. It's when they got closer that we realised they are sharks and stingrays swimming under the yacht. That sight is etched in my memory. It was a great experience to be amidst such tranquil settings, and to just be able to dive in, catch fresh lobster and serve breakfast to the guests on the deck with spectacular views of the clear turquoise blue waters with nothing else for miles away—just nature.

Have you had any unforgettable experiences while at sea?

Storms are part and parcel of this industry. But when bad weather hits, it is best to just sit it out and let it pass. But when you work in pleasure boats and charters, it's not always in the captain's hands. I have been in the midst of a few, but never out of

choice. My worst experience was during a sailing race and I had to man a designated safety powerboat against my better judgement. We had to manoeuvre through six metre-high waves. Almost everyone was on the floor hanging on for dear life and battling seasickness. It was a really scary experience. I decided right then that I would never do it again. I am responsible for the life of everyone on the boat and it's my job to be firm about it and educate them about the risks involved. Luckily my current boss is very understanding—he trusts my judgement when it comes to the weather.

How are you enjoying your stay here in Singapore?

I have been in Singapore as a tourist before, but it's my first trip by sea. It has been an interesting experience familiarising myself with the regulations here, as well as the tidal conditions. My wife and I love travelling and meeting different people and learning about their cultures—it's also part of our job as we have to usually scope the destinations we visit so we can advise our employers and their guests accordingly.

Since we came in earlier than the yacht, we went around to the Singapore Botanic Gardens, Raffles Hotel, Gardens By The Bay and other protected nature parks. Singapore is really beautiful, but though we like visiting cities, we love spending time with nature, listening to the birds and seeing the sea otters—we are country people at heart. The marina has been great as well. It's beautiful with luxurious amenities. The staff is very friendly too. We will be leaving soon (in July 2021) to join another yacht, but hope to be back here after a few months to join *Sea Forever* again.

What advice would you give to others wanting to go to sea?

I am a big dreamer, and I have also been very lucky to have realised many of my dreams. From becoming a captain to skippering a superyacht to scuba diving in some of the most picturesque dive spots in the world—and perhaps not necessarily in that order. Never stop dreaming. The sky is the limit. 📌

It's the time of the year when couples plan an intimate dinner brimming with romantic foods to keep the love flowing. Over the centuries, people have continued to search for different plants, fruits and seafood that could turn on their desires; even though most have not been scientifically proven to be a substance that could really ignite passion. However, it's still interesting to suss out which foods may quicken the heart rate, boost vitality, and potentially seduce. We find out how some ingredients have transformed from ancient symbols of love and fertility to sought-after produce on the modern table.





Pomegranate

Christened different names, from love apple to miracle fruit, pomegranates are renowned for their multiple health benefits. The red coloured fruit has been proven to be very rich in antioxidants, vitamins and minerals. Pomegranate juice lowers cortisol levels (stress hormone) and boosts blood flow; this of course, corresponds with increased testosterone, which helps to heighten vitality.

Ancient Persians have for long recognised the medicinal and healing properties of pomegranates. In India, Ayurveda encourages the consumption of pomegranates for shiny hair and flawless skin. Medieval books on plants have also described the therapeutic effects of this fruit.

In cooking, the gleaming ruby-coloured seeds are often scattered in Persian, Arabic, Jewish and Mediterranean dishes. Because of its stunning colour, pomegranate juice can be served in various ways from desserts to cocktails (try splashing a touch of pomegranate juice into champagne). Check out LATITUDE Bistro's healthy Avocado on Toast partnered with pomegranate, pumpkin seeds, dukkha spice, and sourdough.

FUN FACT

Pomegranates are often linked with fertility and abundance because of their many ruby coloured seeds. The fruit symbolises fertility, beauty and eternal life in both Greek and Persian mythology. It is believed that Aphrodite, the Greek goddess of love, planted the first pomegranate tree.



Mussels

Among the many species of mussels found around the world, about 17 of them are edible. The most common ones are the Blue mussels, Mediterranean mussels, Pacific Blue mussels, and New Zealand green-lipped mussels. Wild mussels live along intertidal zones, clinging to rocks or bottom of the seafloor. These days, a majority of mussels are cultivated as they are considered cleaner and more sustainable. Farmed mussels are grown from ropes that are attached to poles drilled into the ocean floor.

Mussels are high in zinc which can contribute to increased libido. Scientists have discovered that mussels contain an amino acid known as D-aspartic acid, and NMDA (N-methyl-D-aspartate) compounds that may be effective in releasing sex hormones like testosterone and estrogen. Whether or not eating them will boost your desires, the seafood is versatile and delicious when steamed. Tuck into steamed mussels livened up with onions, garlic, thyme, tomatoes, and white wine at LATITUDE Bistro for a good dose of both.

FUN FACT

In ancient Greece, it was believed that all seafoods were the emblems of Aphrodite, the goddess of love. Mussels were among the seafoods popularly consumed in ancient Greece as they were believed to have aphrodisiac powers.



Uni

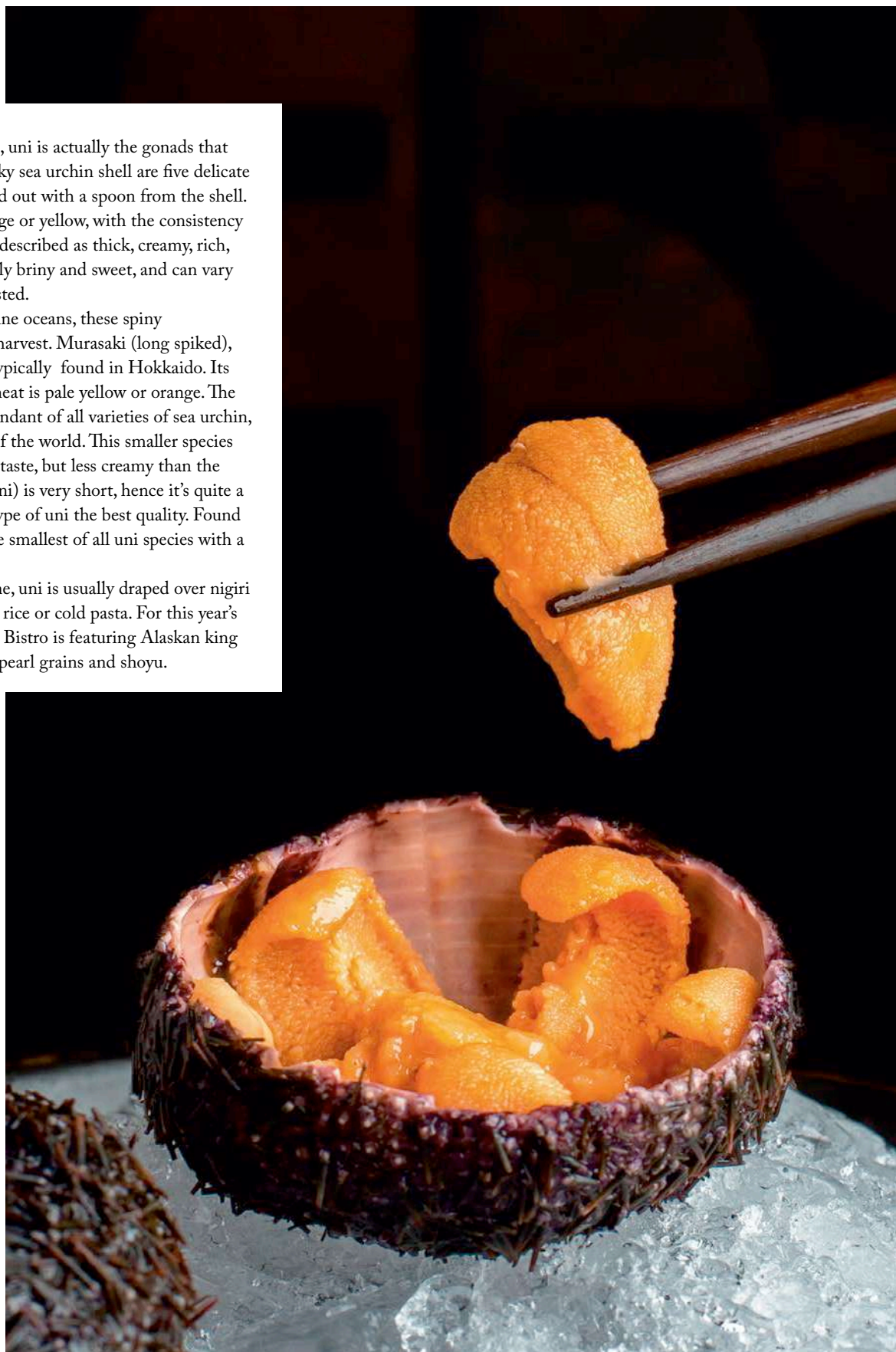
Although often called sea urchin roe, uni is actually the gonads that produces roe. Housed within the spiky sea urchin shell are five delicate lobes—the gonads are gently scooped out with a spoon from the shell. These corals are usually golden, orange or yellow, with the consistency of a firm custard. The texture can be described as thick, creamy, rich, and buttery. The taste is usually lightly briny and sweet, and can vary depending on the place it was harvested.

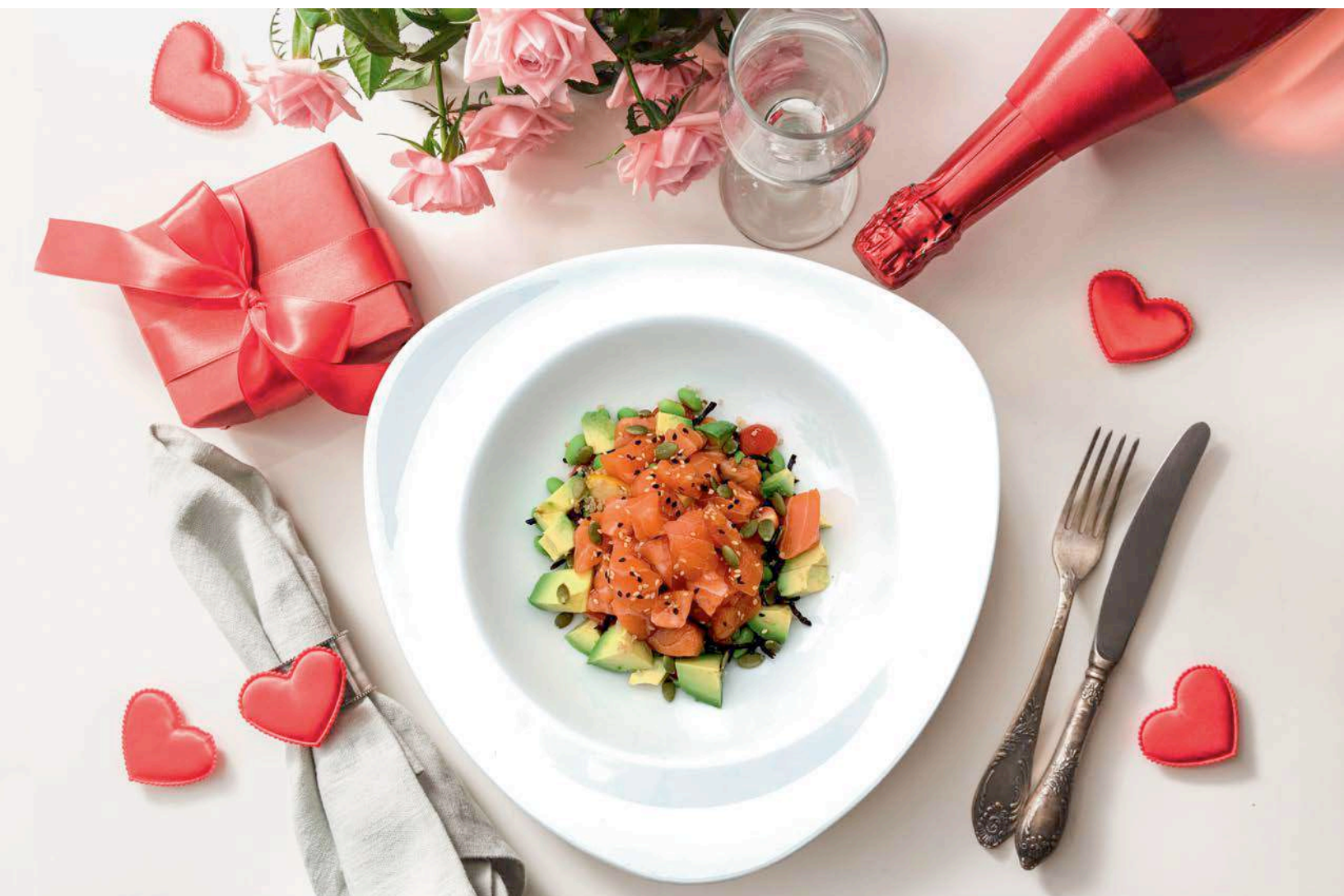
Found on the sandy beds of pristine oceans, these spiny hermaphrodites are very difficult to harvest. Murasaki (long spiked), also known as purple sea urchin, is typically found in Hokkaido. Its richly flavoured, sweet and creamy meat is pale yellow or orange. The Bafun (short spiked) is the most abundant of all varieties of sea urchin, and can be found in different parts of the world. This smaller species have more densely flavoured umami taste, but less creamy than the Murasaki. The season for Aka (red uni) is very short, hence it's quite a rare find. Some chefs consider this type of uni the best quality. Found in Kyushu in southern Japan, it is the smallest of all uni species with a much sweeter and denser taste.

Highly popular in Japanese cuisine, uni is usually draped over nigiri sushi, or gently placed atop Japanese rice or cold pasta. For this year's Valentine's Day menu, LATITUDE Bistro is featuring Alaskan king Crab and Uni Hand Roll with nori, pearl grains and shoyu.

FUN FACT

Uni has been considered an aphrodisiac in Japan for thousands of years. Its perceived exotic appeal is likely because of the gonad's tongue-like appearance and the fact that the edible lobes is a sexual organ. This protein-rich food of virility is also great for promoting blood circulation.





Avocado

Avocado originates from Mexico—the country is the largest producer in the world today. It can also be found in California, and parts of Southern Europe, Australia and India.

Also called “butter fruit” because of its texture and delicate mild taste. Touted as a superfood, avocado has plenty of health benefits as it contains 20 different vitamins and minerals. It is also high in healthy monounsaturated fats.

When the Aztecs discovered the fruit in 500 BC, they decided to call it “ahuacatl”, as the suggestive shape of this fruit resembles a certain part of the male anatomy. The avocado also hangs in pairs on the tree. The Aztecs believed that the fruit promoted fertility for both men and women. Origins of its name aside, the avocado has been known to boost vitality due to its high levels of vitamin E, which helps maintain youthful stamina and energy levels. It is rich in vitamin B6 too, which increases male hormone production.

At LATITUDE Bistro, you can enjoy this healthy ingredient in the Salmon Poke Salad, which comprises quinoa, kale, grilled zucchini, *bijiki*, edamame, avocado, baby red radish, pumpkin seeds, sriracha mayonnaise, and sesame seeds.

FUN FACT

It was the Spanish explorers (to Mexico) in the 16th century that brought it back to Europe. Catholic priests in Spain are believed to have found this fruit so visually sexual, and were therefore forbidden in the country.





Truffles

Truffles are still among the most prized delicacies in the culinary world. They are tubers or fungus that grow underground and near the roots of oak and hazelnut trees. The most coveted are the white species from Alba, Italy, as well as the black winter truffle (sometimes called black diamonds) from Perigord, France. The former is found from September to December and the latter from November to March. Other truffle species also grow in Spain, Chile, New Zealand, China, and the US (Pacific Northwest).

Truffles, in particular black ones, contain natural pheromones called androsterone and androstenol, lending them their musky scent. Although not completely proven yet, truffle's aroma replicates the scent of the male pheromone. Truffles are also high in protein which promotes stamina and energy.

To add depth to your dishes, truffles can be shaved over fluffy scrambled eggs, ribbons of pasta or even a juicy steak. Check out LATITUDE Bistro's Valentine's Day menu, which features a main course of Wagyu Intercostal Sansai Gohan with Black Truffle.

FUN FACT

The truffle is legendary as a food of seduction in ancient Rome and Greece. This elusive ingredient has also been mentioned in antiquated botanical and medical handbooks as an aphrodisiac. French emperor Napoleon Bonaparte had a weakness for truffles and savoured them to increase his masculine potency. They were equally celebrated in the court of King Francis I of France.



Dark Chocolate

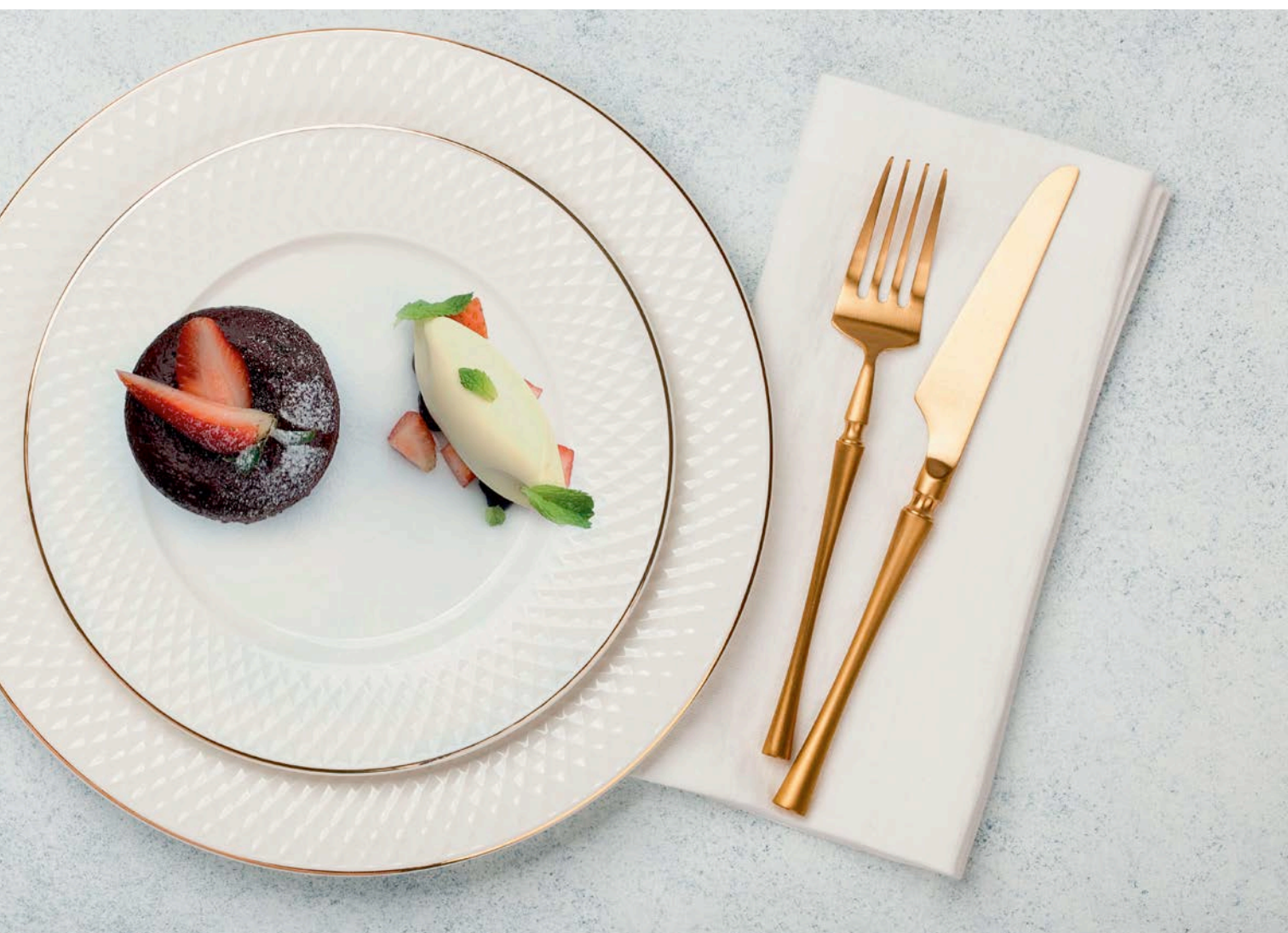
Ancient Aztecs in Mesoamerica consumed cocoa to stimulate desire. Aztec ruler Montezuma is said to have drunk 50 cups of melted hot chocolate each day to intensify his libido. The cacao tree, which has its origins in the South American rainforests was worshipped by the Mayans—as they believed it to be the “food of the gods”. They even used cacao beans as currency to buy food and other items. Sometimes the cocoa is flavoured with spices, honey or flowers.

In 1624, European monks were banned from eating chocolate because it inflamed passions. Fast forward to modern times, food scientists have found that cocoa contains two chemicals known to boost arousal. Tryptophan, a building block of serotonin (feel-good chemical), as

well as phenylethylamine, a stimulant related to amphetamine. They are released by our brains when we are feeling passionate, producing a feeling of euphoria similar to when one is in love—although owing to their small concentration, they would not have any measurable effect on your levels of desire. Nevertheless, dark chocolate with high cocoa content is one of the best sources of antioxidants and packed with minerals. It is also known to improve blood flow. Chocolate treats, the ultimate food of love, is a Valentine’s Day staple around the world today. For the best health benefits, choose quality dark chocolate with 70 per cent or higher cocoa content. 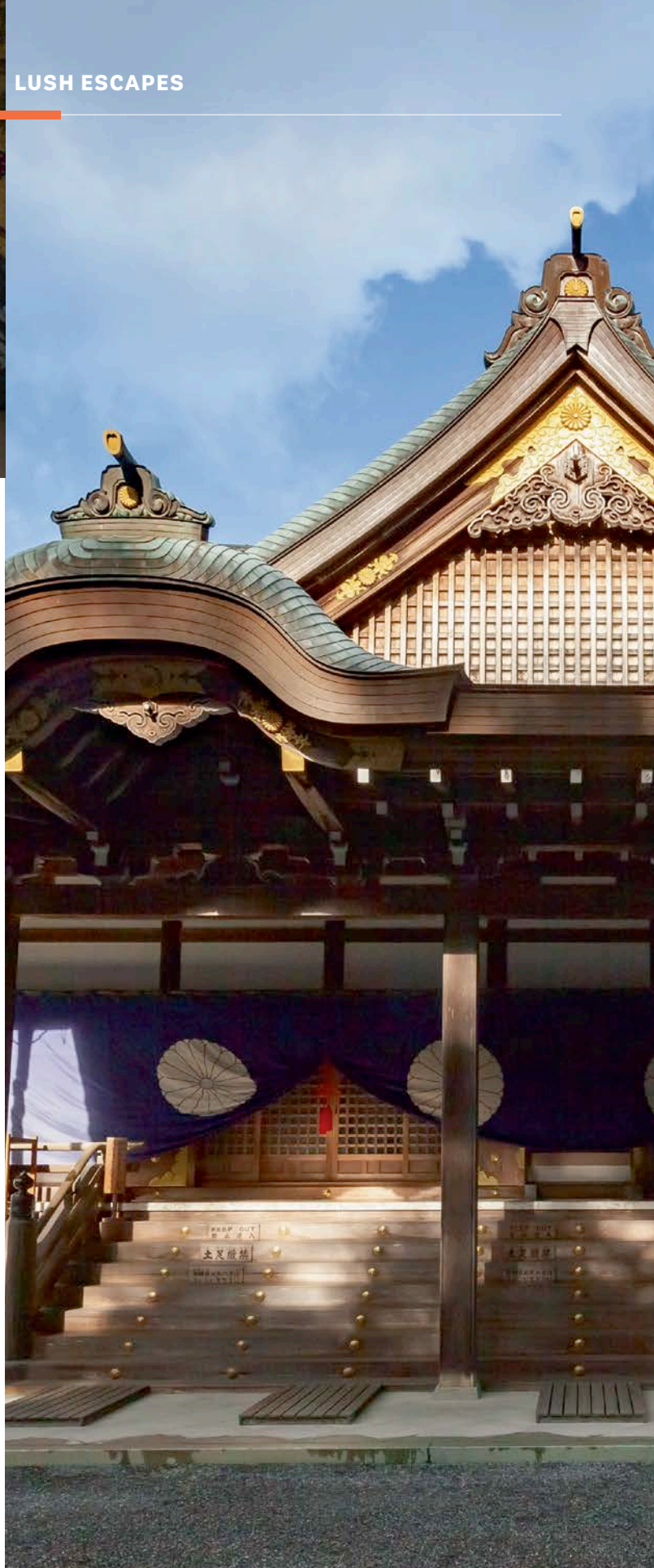
JAPAN

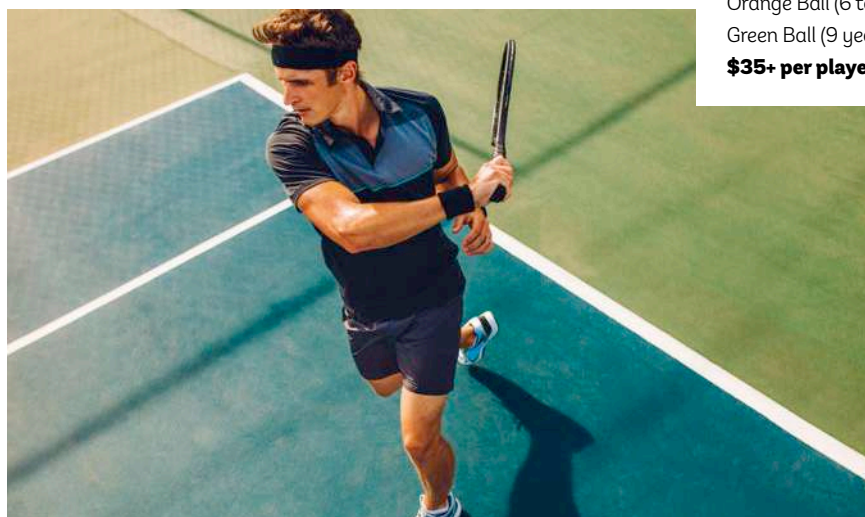

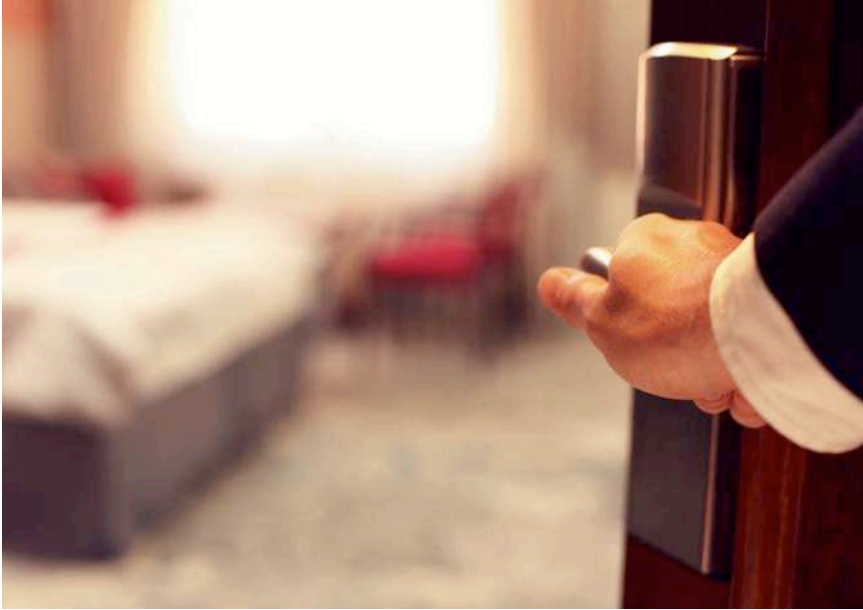

Eco Coral Talk

Sustainability has always been a matter close to our hearts at ONE°15 Marina Sentosa Cove. 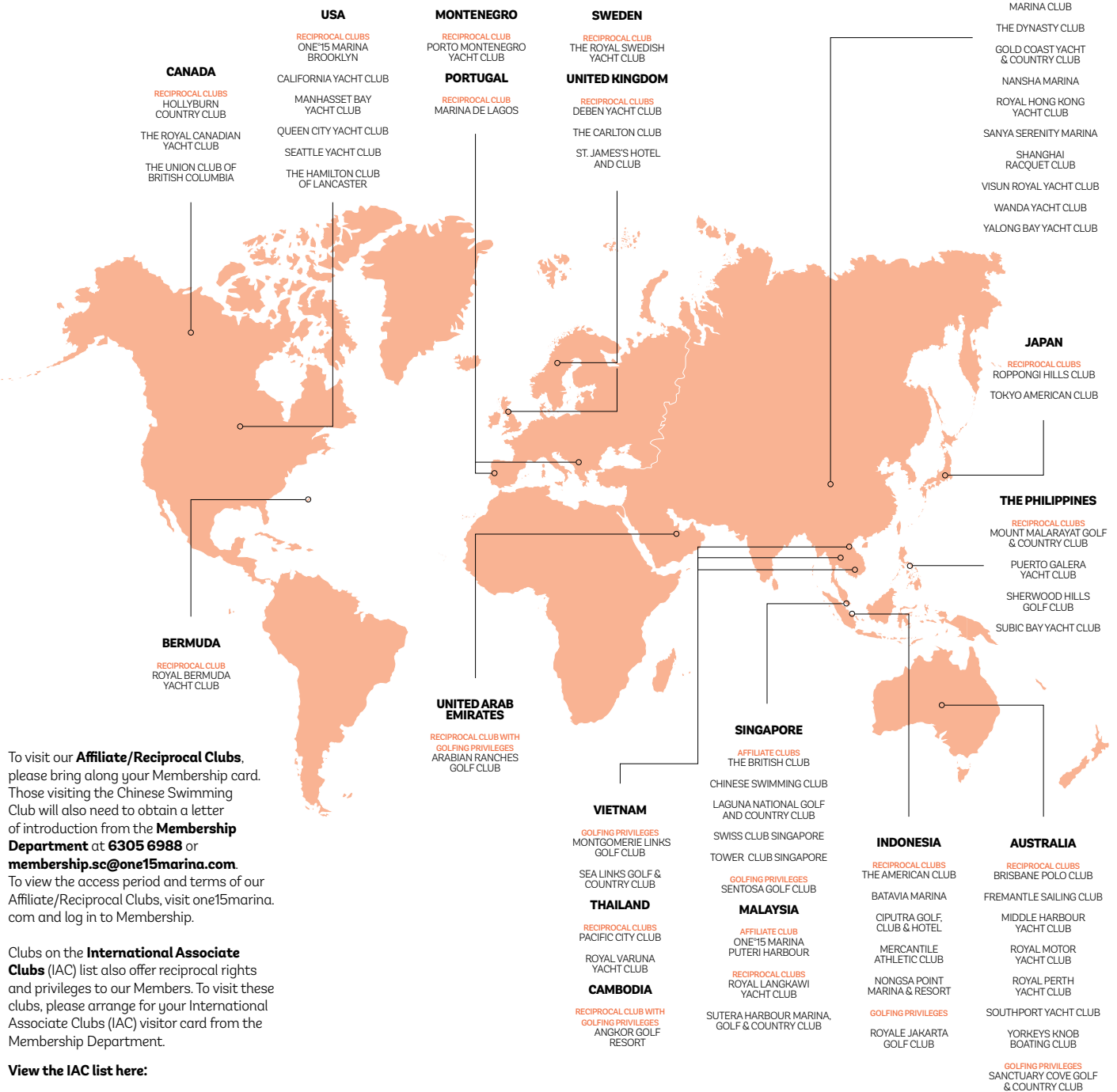
