Escalator Etiquette

Keep to the left when using escalators, allowing others to pass through on the right.

Tipping

Singapore does not practice a tipping culture, as most dining establishments include a service charge in the bill.

Join the Queue

Queuing is a common practice here —simply join in and wait your turn.

Smoking Regulations

Smoking is restricted to designated areas and is prohibited in nature parks and other non-smoking zones.

Keep Our City Clean

Singapore prides itself on its pristine environment. Please ensure you dispose of litter in designated bins.

Drug Laws

The consumption, possession, and sale of drugs are strictly prohibited by law.

Public Transport Etiquette

Food and beverages are not permitted on buses or trains. Offer Priority Seats to the disabled, elderly, pregnant women or children.

WHEN VISITING GARDENS, PARKS, AND NATURE



Use Designated Bins

Keep our parks pristine by disposing of trash properly.

Take Only Photos, Leave Only Footprints

Admire the beauty of our green spaces and refrain from plucking leaves and flowers from plants.

Respect Wildlife

Please maintain a safe distance and refrain from feeding the animals. Be sure to check safety advisories before heading to nature areas.

Keep Noise to a Minimum

Enjoy the serene sounds of nature by keeping noise levels low for the benefit of all park-goers.

Stay on Designated Trails

Stick to marked paths to preserve the natural habitat and for your safety.

Beware of Unwanted Hitchhikers

Invasive species can travel on your shoes and clothing. Cleaning your gear before and after your visit helps protect our natural ecosystems.

Drone Use

If you plan to fly a drone, please do so responsibly and only in designated areas to protect both visitors and wildlife. For more information, visit <https://ask.gov.sg/caas>

WHEN PURCHASING SOUVENIRS AND FOOD

Stay Informed and Buy Responsibly

Before purchasing any wildlife or plant products, ask questions and learn the facts to ensure you are supporting responsible and legal practices.

Some souvenirs or dishes may come from endangered species. By making informed decisions, you can avoid purchasing items made from protected animals or plants that may be illegal to export. This can also prevent unwanted fines or having your items confiscated at customs.

Support Local Artisans

Consider choosing eco-friendly products made by local communities, ensuring they are free from endangered animal or plant materials.

Avoid Purchasing from the Watch List

- Sea turtle products
- Ivory (raw or carved)
- Fur from tigers, seals, polar bears, sea otters, and most spotted cats
- Live monkeys or apes
- Most live birds, including parrots and finches
- Wild bird feathers or mounted birds
- Live reptiles like snakes and lizards
- Certain leather goods made from crocodiles, caiman, or snakes
- Corals and coral products
- Orchids, cacti, or cycads
- Medicinals made from rhinos, tigers, or Asiatic black bears



Questions to Ask Before You Buy

- What is this product made of?
- Where is it from?
- Is it legal to buy and take out of the country?
- Do I need any permits to bring it home?

When Trying Local Foods

Be cautious of dishes made from protected species, such as bluefin tuna, foie gras, shark fin soup, civet coffee, and certain caviar varieties (unless certified from sustainable sources).

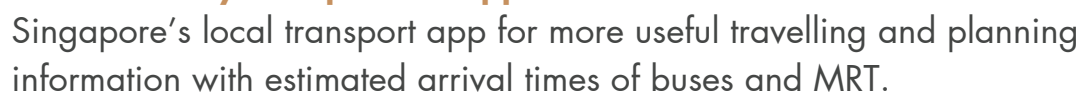

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GETTING INTO SENTOSA COVE

By Sentosa Express

Board the Sentosa Express at VivoCity (Lobby L, 3rd level).

Tickets can be purchased at the same location.

Ticket price: \$4 per entry (Adult and Child aged 3 and above)

By Intra-Island Bus

Once you have entered Sentosa, board Sentosa Bus B and alight at Sentosa Cove Village.

By Shuttle Bus

Board the ONE°15 Marina shuttle bus at Harbourfront MRT Station Exit D.
